



Last Sunday we celebrated a Mass of Thanksgiving on the occasion of Deacon Mark's retirement from the Diaconate. The beautiful Mass and reception were bittersweet. We said goodbye to Deacon Mark who served us so well for 27 years and wished the friend we found in him our very best.

Fr. Richard Gill officiated, assisted by Deacon Mark's good friend and spiritual director, Fr. Paul Waddel. 
welcome Fr. Clifford!

Fr. Clifford Ekwueme has joined us for the summer to help out at St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart parishes.



FEET ON THE GROUND

Last week, I attended a Sacred Art workshop at St. Edmund's Re-



treat on Enders Island off the coast of Mystic, CT. It is a beautiful and peaceful sanctuary dedicated to the work of spiritual care, recovery from addiction, and education in a variety of fine arts within the Christian tradition. My focus was to delve deeper into my newfound interest in drawing, but as usual, the Holy Spirit opened my eyes and heart to more.

My instructor, Anthony Visco, has dedicated his life to creating devotional art that will draw the viewer into an intimate relationship with Jesus and his Church. Other guest artists, and psychological and spiritual counselors have the same end goal. I drove off that island very proud that St. Edmund's is a Catholic institution, but the work they do is consistent with the work the Church has been doing for two thousand years. The Catholic Church gets a bad rap from the secular world, but as disciples, we must open our eyes to the power and great service of the Catholic tradition and its institutions.

Look at the lifesaving work the Sisters of Life are doing to educate society on the truth that all people from the moment of conception to natural death are important to God's Kingdom. Good Counsel offers supportive residential care and community-based services in the NYC area for homeless, expectant and new mothers and their children. The Franciscan Life Center in Meriden, CT helps individuals and families grow personally, psychologically, and spiritually through their outpatient mental health services, and their home and hospice care. Rosary Hill Home provides loving, one-on-one palliative care to those suffering from terminal cancer. And they do not accept any insurance plans – it has been God's generosity that has allowed them to serve us for 121 years!

This only spotlights a sliver of devoted Catholics; the world is filled with groups like this. We need to be proud to be Catholic and speak out boldly about the great work being done in the name of Jesus Christ and the hands and feet of his Church.
