


- 1. Our **Perpetual Adoration** people who pray 24/7 in front of the Blessed Sacrament for all of us.

national day of remembrance for aborted children

On Saturday, September 10, people across the nation came together as people of faith in God to pray for the millions of children who were killed by abortion. Our local prayer location was at Planned Parenthod at 44 Main St, Danbury. We had a very nice assembly from various churches in the area bonded together in prayer. Fr. Richard helped lead the prayer vigil along with this year's 40 Days For Life local campaign leader Don Mallozzi.



As much as the secular world would like us to believe that the choice of a baby in the womb is a woman's choice to keep or discard, we know the truth. The truth is given to us in the Word of God. Every life is precious, from conception to natural death. Even though Roe v Wade was overturned by the Supreme Court, it is now more than ever that we need to keep to our rigid stance in defense of the unborn. States will now try to put into law the right to abortion for any reason!

The United States is still the best nation on earth. We are founded on Christian values. Despite all our differences we must ensure that all lives are respected, especially the unborn. How do we do this? We may not have a national voice or even a local one. We may not be able to affect our own families. But we are not helpless.

Whatever we ask God the Father in Jesus' name, it will be given. But we must be persistent as in the Parable of the Persistent Widow (Luke 18:1-8).

Jesus told his disciples this parable about the necessity for them to pray always without becoming weary. Perseverance shows God that we are serious in our prayer. God always hears our prayers and will respond at the time it will benefit His divine will. Every day there are many senseless acts of violence; killing in our streets, killing in our schools. If you can't make it on Tuesdays, come on another day. Remember, prayer is the most effective weapon we have against the scourge of abortion.



NOT ALONE

Last week, I wrote about the History Channel series, Alone, where trained survivalists compete to stay the longest in one of the most rugged areas of the world. The contestants' behavior can

be very thought provoking. For instance, in their Redemption season, past losers were invited back for a second chance at the big prize in unforgiving Mongolia. Some applied what they had learned previously, others didn't.

After only eight days, one man sobbed uncontrollably because he missed his family; he gave up, went home. It reminded me of Jesus' lesson about building a tower without first calculating our resources. Everyone on Alone misses their family, and this was his second attempt. To leave after a week seems to fulfill Jesus' words,"...onlookers would laugh and say, 'This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish." In contrast, a woman around Day 27 was very hungry and remembered how starvation felt from her previous adventure. She knew it would be foolish to endure that again. In her, I saw the parable of the king who wisely evaluated his chance of defending his nation from a larger enemy. Since she couldn't defeat the enemy of starvation, it was wise for her to go home.

I have told my sons, "You must learn from other people's mistakes. You can't afford to make them all yourself." There have been several seasons of Alone, and the later contestants have watched the successes and failures of the earlier ones. One Redemption competitor, instead of focusing on procuring fish and game, the great sources of protein and fat that have sustained all the past winners, gave in to eating pine bark. He spent two days peeling trees and hanging the thin strips in his shelter. Anyone that we have seen resort to eating pine bark ends up bent over in intestinal agony by the next day. It is curious that he thought he would be an exception. He wasn't. God gives us all the resources we need to win the big prize of heaven. The saints and holy men and women in our lives can guide us, if we are willing to listen, learn, and live like them.

Scripture: Read Luke 14:28-32. What stands out?
