

when I think of Jacob, fighting an angel for his life, when I think of Joshua walking around the walls until they fell, these are the stories I tell myself." Those Old Testament stories are amazing, and it can appear that those people were extraordinary, but they weren't. They were ordinary people like you and me that were born into that time and place for a particular reason.

A good author never writes unnecessary characters into his stories; God is the greatest of authors, and you were created to fill an important need in this time and place.

The climax of the story has passed: Jesus, the Son of God, was born to a woman on Christmas Day, lived 33 years as a human man, healed the sick, expelled demons, taught about the Kingdom of God, and started the Church. During the two thousand years before Jesus' birth, people like Abraham, Jacob, Joshua, and millions of quiet, unknown, faithful people fulfilled their roles of waiting and pointing to the Messiah. We fall in the conclusion part of the story, between Jesus' first and second coming. When the end of the world comes, the final book will be published, and we will have all eternity to read the captivating story, to pour over the riveting chapters, including our own contributions. We all will be in there, in glory or in shame. Have you followed or challenged God's instructions? How do you want your story to be told?
