# while we're at it

Dear Friends,

Remember the old children's story about Chicken Little crying out "the sky is falling" when he was just hit on the head by an acorn? The point was we shouldn't jump to conclusions before checking things out carefully. It's good advice, but sometimes the sky really is falling. We all feel that these days.

Seventy percent of people feel our country is on the wrong track as we start this new year. We've got wars and huge national debts, economic uncertainty, and widespread confusion about sex, gender, and marriage. We've got instability in families and marriages, 40% of children born out of wedlock, abortion as part of the political culture, and anti-family ideologies being pushed on school kids. Fewer people are willing to have



families and we face a declining birth rate. Meanwhile, our leadership can't form a consensus or lead us to deal with the problems. Even in the Church, we lack the conviction to communicate the Gospel without fear, to inspire the faithful, and give hope.

My prayers for our parishes in the year 2023 are the following:

- 1. That we learn to pray and be drawn into the heart of Jesus ever more completely, so he may give us confidence and strength: "I am with you always, to the end of the world!"
- 2. That those who are away, return to Mass and Confession and put their trust in Jesus once again.
- 3. That we build up small groups of disciples who develop missionary hearts and support each other in living the Faith as a witness to all of the power and mercy of Jesus.
- 4. That we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us to the full truth of Jesus and make us strong in holding to all he taught us even in a culture that rejects faith and religion.
- 5. That we all spend more and more time in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament to experience the closeness and the love of Jesus.
- 6. That we live our faith fully and radiate out to the world the joy of a relationship with Jesus transformed by his love and mercy.
- 7. That we inspire others to long for Jesus, who is the answer to every human question and who reveals to us the great things God created us for.

That might be a lot for just one year, but we've got to get started.



Every year I tell myself that I am going to make this Advent the best ever - one that is meaningful and makes me feel truly prepared to meet Jesus when Christmas arrives. I want to understand the fullness of the holy holiday, apart from the commercialism that exists, and feel trans-

formed by God in a new way. Every year I try different ways to meet that goal by reading, watching videos, and having meaningful scripture delivered to my inbox. Each year it does bring me a bit closer to Jesus, but I always come away wanting a little more.

This year I saw that the parish was offering **Rejoice**, **an Advent Preparation Bible Study** one night a week for each of the four weeks leading up to Christmas. Having been moved by a similar Ascension Press program for Lent, I decided not only to sign up, but to enroll my husband as well (and tell him that later). Each week involved listening to the readings for the upcoming Sunday, watching short videos, discussing it as a group, and praying - together and independently - letting the words move us in the way God is trying to speak to each one of us. It was incredible how the simple daily activities made me feel more prepared for Mass on Sunday and more prepared to hear what God might be trying to say to me.

Not only did we learn a lot from Lynda, our instructor, and Fr. Toupes who wrote the program, but we also learned a lot from each other. For some of us, it was an introduction to new ways to pray. Some learned to hear God more clearly than ever. For me, not only did I experience the most meaningful Advent ever, but as a new parishioner, I really felt welcomed as a new member of the community and made some new friends. Although everyone's journey is unique,



we all found ourselves moving closer to Jesus and more prepared for His coming. This experience definitely made Advent and Christmas more meaningful.

#### a franciscan christmas

The manger scene that we have in our home at Christmas originated from St. Francis of Assisi's love for Christmas and how he celebrated it in the year 1223. To celebrate his great love of the Incarnation, while visiting a hermitage in Greccio. Italy. Francis desired to celebrate Christmas with great joy. The chapel of the hermitage was too small to invite the many guests he wished to invite for such a great feast, so Francis found a cave, and asked residents of the village to prepare a manger scene. Together they refashioned the stable of Bethlehem. Over the manger, containing a figure of the baby Jesus, he put the Altar, where the Christmas Midnight Mass was to be celebrated. The whole town came! St. Francis preached about the Humility of God shown in the Incarnation (God become flesh in Jesus). As Francis approached the babe in the manger under the Altar, and, as he knelt down to pay homage, the babe seemed to come alive!

Each year the San Damiano Fraternity of Secular Franciscans recalls this night in 1223, when the Babe of Bethlehem came alive in the hearts of that whole town. This year as part of the evening, they told the legend of "**The Christmas Path**" and how the lighting of lanterns or candles beside walkways and around homes has become a cherished tradition during the Christmas Season. The evening included the singing of many familiar Christmas carols.

It was no coincidence that St. Francis placed the Altar directly above the manger during that first nativity scene.

It is in the Eucharist that the Incarnation continues each time Mass is celebrated. St. Francis shows us that each time we celebrate Mass, we celebrate Christmas!!



#### today's feast day of mary

The use of the word "solemnity" here is not a statement about Mary's personality. It is a designation used for certain days within the liturgical (church-based) calendar of the Church. Solemnities are

the highest rank of liturgical celebration, higher than feast days or memorials. By celebrating a solemnity dedicated to Mary's motherhood, the Church highlights the significance of her role in the life of Christ.

There's a beautiful spiritual significance in celebrating her during the heart of the Christmas season. Pope Paul VI, in his apostolic exhortation Marialis Cultus (1974), called the Solemnity of Mary "a fitting occasion for renewing adoration of the newborn Prince of Peace, for listening once more to the glad tidings of the angels (Luke 2:14), and for imploring from God, through the Queen of Peace, the supreme gift of peace."

#### **MOTHER MARY**

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. This honor reminds us of the role that the Blessed Virgin played in the plan of our salvation. As a cradle Catholic, I find it curious that other strong Christians dismiss Mary as unimportant. Many believe that we should pray only to Jesus and that it is disrespectful to Him to pray to his mother. Kimberly Hahn, a famous convert from Protestantism, tells that they would even revise the Christmas hymns to remove Mary's name. Over two thousand years, the Catholic Church has carefully developed its doctrine on Mary - no organization is more cautious and articulate in forming its teaching. I trust its wisdom and insight and that its conclusions make sense.

The Church teaches that Mary herself was immaculately conceived, born without sin. How could the Father conceive his own perfect son into the womb of a sinful woman? All of us born after Eve carries the burden of sin. Jesus' mother needed to be pure like Eve was before the fall, to have that intimate relationship with God that Eve originally had. Mary is the new Eve, a fresh start for humanity, and she was able to carry and then raise Jesus perfectly. That makes sense, right?

Jesus must have had a very close relationship with his mother and after Joseph died, I expect their bond grew tighter. After my husband died eight years ago, my two sons and I grew even closer. They instinctively want to help and protect me, and I want to support and encourage them. They respect me and are offended when someone shows me disrespect. I believe Jesus feels the same. No one else on earth spent 30 years, day in and day out with Jesus, who could possibly know and love Him more?

St. Augustine said, "The Blessed Virgin Mary still labors today, but no longer with Jesus, with each one of us, until we are born into eternity." I love that image. Mary has enwrapped each of us within her and wants to deliver us into a new life — eternal life in heaven with her Son. 
