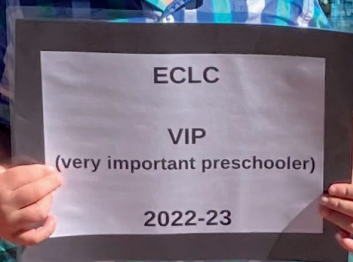

St. Lawrence Early Childhood Learning Center is a Catholic based, academic preschool which offers extended daycare services. There are half day and full day programs available for Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 aged children. The curriculum in our program is based upon both the Archdiocese of New York "Essentials for Learning" and the "Core Standards" that have been handed down from New York State which provides kindergarten readiness to each student. We are licensed by New York State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS).

Our classroom teachers are highly qualified, holding Masters Degrees in Education, as well as New York State Teaching Certificates. All staff are required by OCFS to obtain yearly training hours and attend seminars developed for Early Childhood Educators. Every staff member is CPR/AED/First Aid certified.

St. Lawrence O'Toole also offers two other structured programs for younger children which are both social/play based. Our "Just the Two of Us" is a program for (approximate) 2 year olds and a caregiver. Our "Twos Crew" is a drop off program.

while we're at it

Dear Friends,

I was able to get away for a few days last week to Stockbridge, MA, for a little break, and to spend some time at the Divine Mercy Shrine there. I prayed for you and everyone at our two parishes that we grow closer to God and live in his love and mercy. The Shrine is an oasis, a holy place of prayer less than two hours away, and worth the trip, even when most of the days were rain and snow...

On my way back I was reminded of two unpleasant things coming to New York, courtesy of our politicians in Albany.



Massachusetts is ahead of New York by a year or two in the rush to legalize the sale of marijuana products. But 2023 is the year it all becomes legal in New York as well. As I drove down through the pretty towns in the Berkshires, every single one had several "cannabis dispensaries" along the main roads as common as convenience stores and better publicized with billboards. Parking lots were full as if people were rushing to do their Christmas shopping.

There are so many reasons this sort of thing is a terrible idea, apart from the fact that getting high is sinful - just like getting drunk. But neither are there any social goods that come from making it easier for the population to get high. We already have serious problems educating and motivating our young people to build lives of passion and purpose, to be engaged in something bigger than themselves, and to contribute to the real good of society. This makes it worse, not better. What is even more insidious is when government sponsors these vices in order to tax them for its own expansion. Stay tuned - more bad news is on the way with this.

Our Governor has signed a bill allowing "human composting" in place of burial. This could only be a priority for those who don't believe in the dignity of the body. It's a process that is what it sounds like. Deceased persons are prepared to be the raw material for fertilizer for plants and trees.

Our society used to have the utmost respect for the bodies of the deceased because we understood the body as an essential part of who we are as "made in the image and likeness of God." That's why we Catholics bury our loved ones in sacred ground, in dignified Catholic cemeteries where the body awaits the last day when Jesus will raise our remains from the dead and our body will be reunited with our eternal soul in the glory of heaven.

So - two more issues on which we are called to be counter-cultural and not go along with the trends around us. Prayer and perseverance.

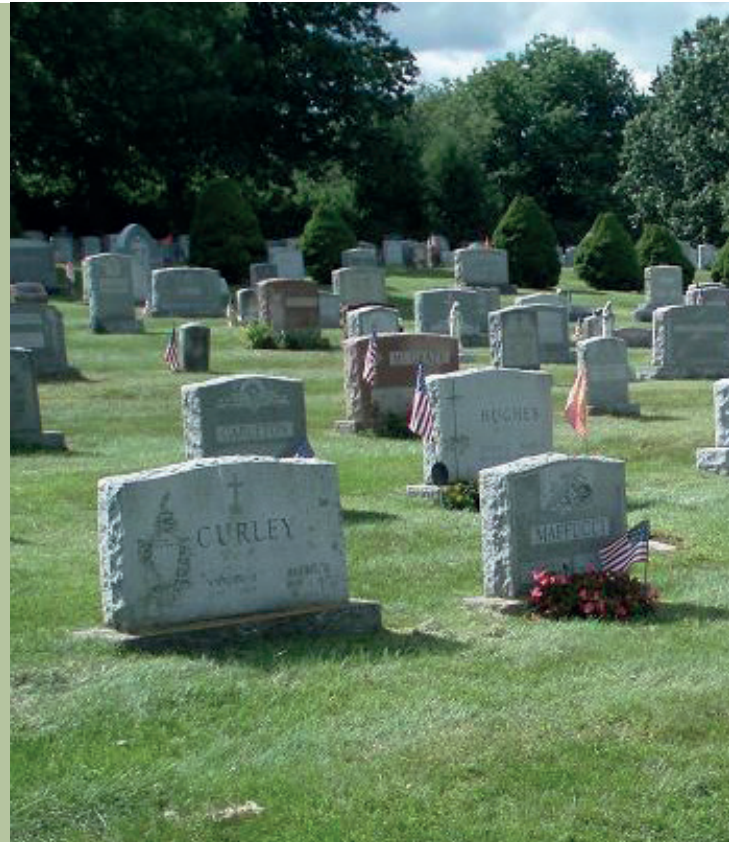

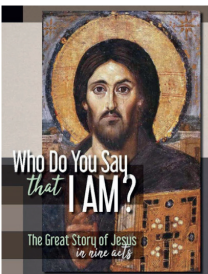

who do you say that I am?

I was happy and very grateful to have Saturday free to attend the all-day retreat at St. Lawrence O'Toole. The title of the retreat **Who Do You Say That I Am?**, intrigued me. The importance of spending the whole day focused on Jesus, left me with much inspiration and insight. One of the insights that particularly stood out for me was in a quiet room alone where a crucifix was displayed. I gazed at Jesus crucified. After gazing for moments, I'm not sure for how long, I answered the question "What do I want to say to You?" as Jesus hung there on the cross. A few questions overcame me.

How can you allow yourself to do this?
 How can You accept such horror?
 Who are You?
 You did this for me?
 For me to know Your Kingdom?
 This is what God, who is LOVE, wanted?

And a thought came to me. Is my definition of LOVE distorted?

My eyes were opened. LOVE is not the warm and fuzzy feeling I seem to want. LOVE is sacrifice. It is dying on my crosses. It is at times, going through anger, pain, and even horror with those I love. It may not be the horror Jesus suffered, but certainly, my life doesn't escape suffering. The anger of opposing views, the pain of not having others the way I want them to be, the horror of devastating moments in my life when LOVE just doesn't seem visible. How do I love in times like these?



Perhaps I can say "Yes" to LOVE when I want to hesitate. When I am afraid to LOVE. When I feel I am not qualified to LOVE. Even when pain surrounds me... Perhaps I can be an offering to another in these moments.



To answer, "Who Do You Say That I Am?" On the cross, Jesus, You are the greatest LOVE. You are our Holy Offering.

Teach me, Lord, to be courageous in those times when love doesn't look pretty. When LOVE doesn't feel so warm and fuzzy.



Is silence already prayer?

The mere absence of noise is not silence ...

To the worldly mind, silence seems empty, intimidating, a waste of time. But silence is indispensable for living the Faith. The essence of silence is self-emptiness, docility, receptivity, detachment, desire, stillness, listening, communion, attention. "Silence is not merely keeping quiet, but it is the attitude of one who lives standing before a 'You' who is present, entreating a 'You' who is present" (L. Giussani).

Servant of God Catherine de Hueck Doherty defined silence this way:

"True, silence is sometimes the absence of speech—but it is always the act of listening. The mere absence of noise (which is empty of our listening to the voice of God) is not silence. A day filled with noise and voices can be a day of silence, if the noises become for us the echo of the presence of God. When we speak of ourselves and are filled with ourselves, we leave silence behind. When we repeat intimate words of God that he has left within us, our silence remains intact."

We require silence in order to hear God since the noise of our own thoughts and distractions drowns out his voice within us. We cannot be silent if we are endlessly seeking our peace, our happiness, and our satisfaction in things outside of God. Through interior silence, God speaks with us, communicating his love in a way that draws our whole being to his heart. It has been said that it is our silence in the Heart of Christ that teaches us to despise the force of our own attraction to evil.

To Poor Clare Sister Mary of the Holy Trinity (+1942), the Lord revealed this: "I speak to each soul; if there are some who do not hear me, it is because they do not listen to me. There must be a profound silence, because my voice is soft. The soul must be freed from all engrossing thoughts." As St. Thomas Aquinas expressed it, "God is honored by silence because we know that we are unable to comprehend him."

Silence is a surrendering of self that centers us and that puts preoccupation on mute. And silence is therapeutic, as St. Gregory of Nazianzen observes: "Silence is mightier than words. It clothes the wreckage that befalls us in the deep fold of forgetfulness." And who doesn't need that!

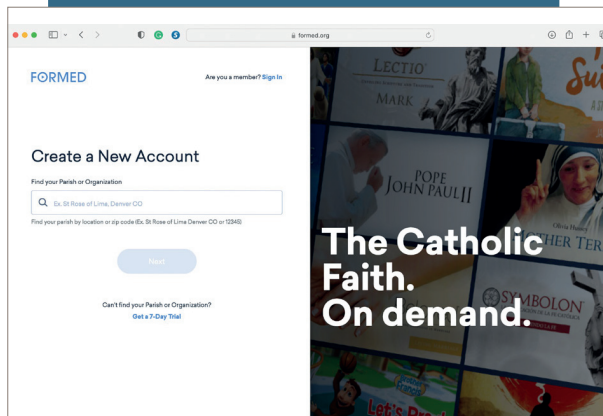
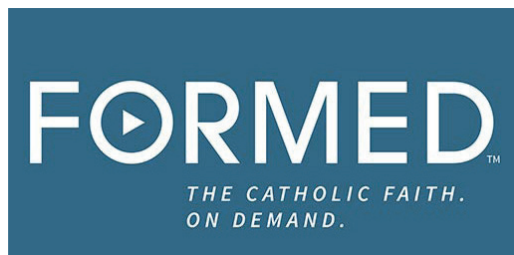

RETREAT INTO JESUS

Last Saturday at the “Who Do You Say That I Am?” retreat, I found myself standing and scanning the room, focusing table by table, watching the peaceful faces reading Scripture, contemplating it, and journaling. We have offered this retreat four times now and the results are always the same. Whether seasoned Scripture students or Alpha newbies, cradle Catholics or converts, men or women, English or Spanish speaking, St. Lawrence, Sacred Heart, or people from outside parishes, all are touched by our God who longs to have a personal relationship with them.

As coordinator of the event, I can find it challenging to get to know everyone, remember their names, and have the time to learn a little about each. Studying the scene, I couldn't help

but think how Jesus knows each one of them better than they know themselves and He is communicating with each of them simultaneously, loving each unconditionally and longing for them to hear Him and trust Him to guide their lives. He longs to share in their joys, alleviate their suffering, relieve their anxieties, and clarify their decision-making.

Next time you are in church, scan the pews and think of that. Jesus is there waiting to communicate with each of us simultaneously, in a way that is meaningful and relevant to our state of life and needs at that very moment. Remarkable, but true.

Taking a day away from our busy lives to immerse ourselves in prayerful reflection can be mistakenly viewed as a luxury. It is interesting that the word “retreat” also means “strategic withdrawal.” Appropriate. We withdraw from our routine to regroup and return stronger, and more focused. When an opportunity arises for you to attend a retreat, take it. Do not hesitate, second-guess, or talk yourself out of it. In the meantime, make time to communicate with Jesus every day. Even 15 minutes of meditative prayer, reading Scripture, and contemplating it gives Jesus the time He needs to break through our barriers, touch our hearts, and transform our lives.

Scripture: Read Luke 9:18-21. What stands out?

Call to Action: Who is Jesus to you? Will you give Him the quiet time He needs to speak to you, guide you, and reveal his love for you?
