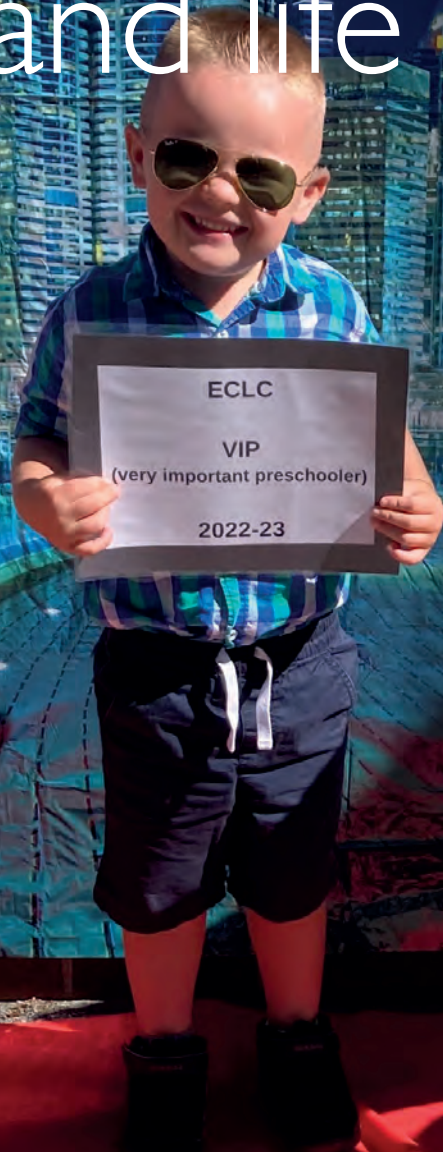

St. Lawrence Early Childhood Learning Center is a Catholic based, academic preschool which offers extended daycare services. There are half day and full day programs available for Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 aged children. The curriculum in our program is based upon both the Archdiocese of New York "Essentials for Learning" and the "Core Standards" that have been handed down from New York State which provides kindergarten readiness to each student. We are licensed by New York State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS).

Our classroom teachers are highly qualified, holding Masters Degrees in Education, as well as New York State Teaching Certificates. All staff are required by OCFS to obtain yearly training hours and attend seminars developed for Early Childhood Educators. Every staff member is CPR/AED/First Aid certified.

St. Lawrence O'Toole also offers two other structured programs for younger children which are both social/play based. Our "Just the Two of Us" is a program for (approximate) 2 year olds and a caregiver. Our "Twos Crew" is a drop off program.

while we're at it

Dear Friends,

Last Friday 40 of us headed to Washington, DC, for the 50th annual **March for Life**, and the first since Roe v. Wade was overturned. It was awesome to see the hundreds of thousands who came out to support a simple idea: that every human life, no matter what stage of development, is sacred and should have the right to life. We need to work with our representatives in Albany to protect human life. That is a tall order given the makeup of New York politics, but we never quit. Join the fight for life.



St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart will be launching **Gianna's House** in the spring – a pregnancy resource center to help a woman choose life and to provide her with the support she needs. Planned Parenthood and the medical industry have a huge financial stake in abortion and abortion pills. But Christians need to get behind women in complicated situations with alternatives that don't involve killing an innocent baby. It's time for our parishes to step up and do something solid.

At the **other end of life**... when dealing with loved ones who are terminally ill, we know the stress and pressure: dealing with uncertainty, then with doctors, tests, procedures, and possibly hospice. There are hard decisions to make and heroic care and love are needed. I see so many parishioners do this so admirably, giving a powerful witness to the dignity of every human life even as it fades.

But don't forget the spiritual needs of the terminally ill. Make sure you call me and get me there for **Confession** and **Anointing of the Sick** – these are powerful sacraments that give grace and peace of soul to the loved one approaching their end. I'm never too busy to go for the sick and dying. And we can send Eucharistic ministers regularly to bring them Holy Communion.

Finally, be sure to arrange a funeral and **burial in sacred ground** – a Catholic cemetery if at all possible. That is how Catholics have always honored the dead. A bad trend that skips funerals and burials is unfortunately growing today. Let's resist that trend. St. Lawrence Cemetery has just opened a new section with 900 double graves. Having a dignified place where they are laid to rest and where we pray for them is how we show respect for our loved ones. Even when cremated we must bury the ashes or put them in a columbarium in a cemetery. Never keep them at home.

Human life has dignity because we come from God and we are destined to return to him. Thanks for being part of the culture of life.

CARDINAL'S ANNUAL APPEAL

Every year we help the Cardinal reach the Archdiocesan goal of \$21 million for charities and support of projects in the Archdiocese. The goal for St. Lawrence this year is \$77,000. For Sacred Heart it is \$11,000. At both our parishes, we reached about 90% of our goal, contributing an amazing \$80,000 from over 200 parishioners.

The Cardinal's Annual Appeal helps:

- \$9M in assistance to financially vulnerable parishes – providing the operational budget for parishes to remain a refuge for their communities through the sacraments and ministries.
- \$5M to Charitable Outreach, Pastoral Support – including administrative costs for Catholic Charities and funding for the programming of the Young Adult Outreach, Hispanic Ministry, Black Ministry offices.
- \$4M to Evangelization, Communications, Catholic Education – providing resources and ministries like the GoodNewsRoom, Youth Faith Formation, and Religious education.
- \$2M to Care for Retired Parish Priests – providing a refuge in their old age to those who served the Lord and us faithfully for many years.
- \$1M to the Seminary – providing the formation of the next generation of priests so we may never be without the source and summit of our faith, that is, the Eucharist.

I'm sure if we can reach 300 donors between our two parishes, we can reach our goals for this year.

You've probably received a letter from the Cardinal already, along with a pledge card.

You can give that way or online. We also have envelopes in the Church to make it easy to give.

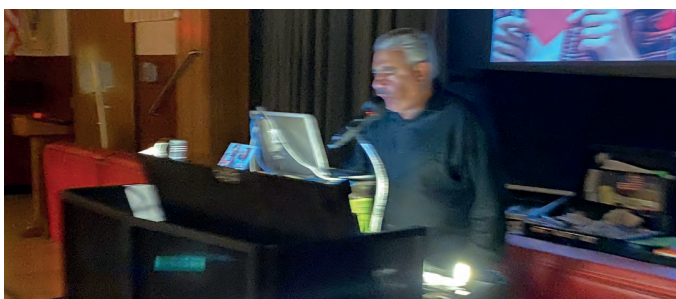

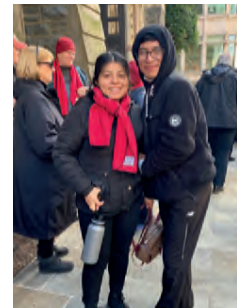
