Dear Friends,

Maybe you got the ashes, but that was a one-day thing and now they're just a memory.

What about the other 39+ days of Lent? Sure, we all have to do meatless Fridays during Lent, and we're encouraged to "give something up." But most times we give up something that's bad for us. My dad used to take a six-week break from cigarettes; others cut out the sweets. That sort of thing is a good idea all the time.



But how do we make Lent something lasting and life-changing? Four good ideas, right here at our parish:

1. **Get your Eucharistic life in shape with Seasons of Praise** every Monday at 7:00 pm. We're bringing in great priests to speak and great praise and worship music for a deep experience of Jesus' presence in the Blessed Sacrament. There's nothing more spiritual or more Catholic than that. Come and experience that power. And our Arise prayer ministry will be there if you have something you need them to pray with you about.
2. **It's good to see the Confession lines** – every Monday and Friday from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm. A good Lent means you have got to make a good Confession. Don't worry if it's been a while – the priest will greet you and help you. And you'll leave with that weight lifted and feeling new.
3. **Somebody you know needs to get back on track with their faith.** Probably more than just one. Bring someone along to Alpha – it starts Wednesday night at 7:00 pm. It's a meal together, a video, and a conversation with new friends. Easy, non-judgmental, and affirming. Alpha starts people back on the road to a relationship with God all over again. 4. **Work on your marriage...** Alpha Marriage for couples is a great way to improve your communication and appreciation for each other. It's a date night each week for seven weeks. Don't let your most important relationship fall into routine... renew it by registering at BrewsterAlpha.com.

NOT AS THEY APPEAR

I was recently reflecting on how often things are not as they seem. Looking at helpless baby Jesus, no one could have seen the power of his divinity. We must also admit that every single embryo is just as valuable as the most important human being that ever existed. Brilliant corporate executives, renowned surgeons, Pope Francis, St. Francis, they all were embryos with unrevealed futures at one time too.

The Blessed Sacrament appears to be a wheat wafer, but as with the babe, Jesus' divinity is simply hidden from our eyes. The Mass appears to be a gathering of local neighbors when it is so much bigger in reality. We are in heaven when we are in Mass; the veil between heaven and earth is lifted, and the church is filled with angels and saints worshipping with us. We don't see them with our eyes, but that doesn't make them less

real. If people understood, they would never see Mass as boring.

It appears that we should be striving for health, wealth, and happiness, but in reality, no matter how hard we try, most people have some physical disability, a high percentage of the world's population are poor, and happiness is fleeting. Similarly, it seems that suffering should be avoided at all costs and that parents should protect their children from any form of hardship. But sacrifice, hardship, and discipline that accompany suffering forges wisdom, knowledge, and fortitude—three of the important Gifts of the Holy Spirit. "He who has not suffered, what does he know?" Henry Suso.

I recently read an enlightening message on the Sacrament of Marriage. "One of the functions is to sanctify the individuals involved. Over the years they will bring out the best in each other, but also the worst. The imperfections have to surface in order for them to be addressed. And so, when the worst comes forth, it is not necessarily a sign of a marriage failing. It is a sign of a marriage working." Fr. Patrick Winslow.

As disciples, we need to adjust our lens to see as Christ does. We are not designed to see and understand God with our eyes, but when we fine-tune our hearts, our vision of life becomes clear. Then rather than being burdened by poverty, sickness, and hardship, we can be empowered by grace.

I do something that helps someone else. This year I am on the prayer team for Alpha. While the Alpha program takes place in the dining hall, we will be praying for them. Prayer is powerful and everyone needs prayer. If

we can change the life of just one person and bring one person closer to Jesus, and have just one person understand Jesus better, how great would that be! One person at a time.

Alpha begins Wednesday, March 8th. Think of the people around you. Think of Lent. Come to Alpha and bring one person with you. With one person at your side, you already know someone at your table. One night a week. I know how difficult it is to come home after working all day and go to a meeting. This Lent, extend a hand and invite someone to join you as you experience Alpha together and discover all that life has to offer.

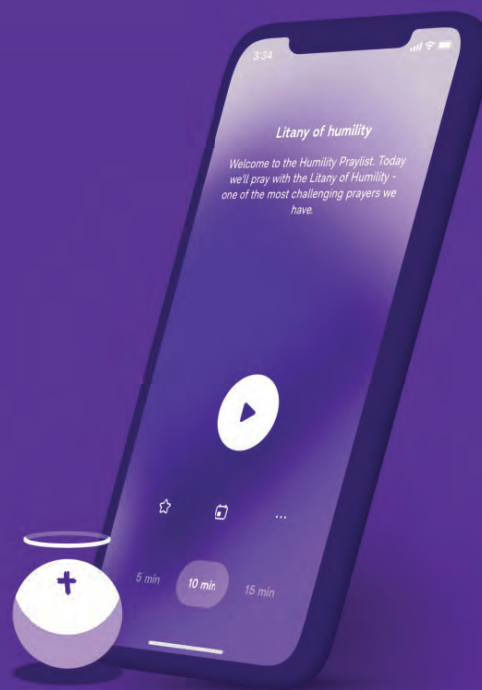
