while we're at it

Dear Friends,

Everyone is saying that we didn't really get winter this year (Fine by me!), and now that we are on to daylight savings time, we're unofficially into Spring this weekend. So it's time for spring cleaning at our parishes, as well as some upgrades for our buildings and grounds. Some highlights:

At **Sacred Heart**, we replaced two leaky roofs over the rectory garage and part of the house. Most of it had been done a few years ago in the aftermath of the tornado that swept right through Putnam Lake, courtesy of our insurance company. Since this was a part left undamaged by the storm, they didn't cover it.

If you haven't done the **outdoor Stations of the Cross** at Sacred Heart, go out to the woods and do so. We put them up with funds from the **Parish Improvement Campaign**, and just now had a tree company come and clean out dead and dying trees near the Stations.

New and **safer steps are installed in front of the St. Lawrence gym**, making it easier for everyone to get in and out after Sunday coffee and donuts.

Work on our new parking lot is underway and before long we'll have a much better parking layout for our campus. We're grateful to the Village of Brewster Planning Board for approving the project.

Soon we'll be adding a shrine for the Blessed Mother on Prospect St. and some new statues (St. Teresa of Calcutta, St. Michael, St. John Paul II, and St. Padre Pio) in our prayer grotto. We'll do some landscaping enhancements to make it more beautiful and a wonderful spot for prayer and reflection outside the Church and Adoration Chapel.



A few people have been very generous so far in getting these projects going but we'll have to raise some funds to get this all done. I'm sure you'll all come through as you always do.

I mentioned at some of the Masses that occasionally people attending our Church have parked and blocked the driveways of our immediate neighbors on Prospect St. Please be careful to park only in our lot or at approved spots on the street out of consideration for everyone.

Finally, let's not forget our good **Lenten resolutions**. One of the best is to come every Monday in Lent to **Seasons of Praise Holy Hour** starting at 7:00 in the Church. **Fr. Bobby Carolan** of Annunciation in Crestwood will be with us this week. After it is over, musician and artist **Michael Corsini** will play and present his artwork at a reception in the gym.

KEEP HOLY HIS NAME

When I was a little girl in religious education, the nuns taught us to say, "*Blessed be God, blessed be his holy Name,*" in our hearts, whenever we heard someone take the Lord's name in vain. That instruction has taken firm root, and I do it very automatically still to this day. Unfortunately, I find myself saying it often. The general population, including Catholics, seem oblivious to the fact that taking the Lord's name in vain is a mortal sin, it breaks the Third Commandment, and it is extremely disrespectful to God.

People don't seem to realize that when we say God's name, we are calling Him to us. If you and I were in the same room and you said, "Lynda," I would turn to you to see what I might do for you. God does the same; he hears every word that

comes out of our mouths and hearts, and when we say his name, He comes to us. Think of all the times you hear Jesus' name said in profane ways. Even all the vain ways that people use God's name: OMG, claiming to swear to God, etc. Every time God's name is spoken, He responds to that person.

Almost as bad is the profanity that is imposed on us in general conversation by men and women alike these days. Words that would get our mouths washed out with soap fifty years ago have been integrated into normal conversations and all forms of entertainment: television, movies, songs, and books. It is so accepted that it doesn't even alarm us anymore. Another example of embracing evil. As disciples, we need to keep the bar high on our behavior and teach our children to do the same. That may mean continuing to remind our adult children. As Christians, we need to stand apart, not allow ourselves to be dragged willingly into the cesspool of modern culture.

Scripture: Read Deuteronomy 5:11. What stands out?

Call to Action: Memorize the short prayer above and say it in your heart when you hear the Lord's name disrespected. Jesus taught The **Golden Arrow** prayer to a Carmelite Nun in 1843. Join me to pray it daily for a change in our culture.

The Golden Arrow (Prayer in Reparation for Blasphemy)
May the most holy, most sacred, most adorable, most mysterious, and unutterable Name of God be always praised, blessed, loved, adored, and glorified in Heaven, on earth, and under the earth by all the creatures of God, and by the Sacred Heart of our Lord Jesus Christ in the most Holy Sacrament of the altar.

pope benedict XVI's very concrete advice for being a little holier every day

5. Every day, take note of a sign from God

In 2009, Benedict XVI was in the vanguard of the idea of the “bullet journal,” a diary in which we would note the signs that God sends us. The purpose is to become aware of and keep a record of how attentive God is to each of his creatures and how much he loves us. *“The individual events of the day are hints that God is giving us, signs of the attention he has for each one of us. How often does God give us a glimpse of his love! To keep, as it were, an ‘interior journal’ of this love would be a beautiful and salutary task for our life!”* he said.

6. Contemplating works of art

As a musician and music lover, Benedict XVI experienced how beauty leads to God. During a general audience in August 2011, he shared how much a Bach concert in Munich had touched him: *“At the end of the last passage, one of the Cantatas, I felt, not by reasoning but in the depths of my heart, that what I had heard had communicated truth to me, the truth of the supreme composer, and impelled me to thank God.”* *The via pulchritudinis, the “way of beauty,” is one of the ways that can lead to God and help us encounter him.*

“There are artistic expressions that are true paths to God, the supreme Beauty, and that even help to grow in our relationship with Him, in prayer,” Benedict XVI affirms. *“These are works that were born from faith and express faith. We can see an example of this when we visit a Gothic cathedral: we are enraptured by the vertical lines that soar skywards and uplift our gaze and our spirit,”* or when we listen to a piece of sacred music *“that plucks at our heartstrings”* and *“our mind, as it were, expands and turns naturally to God.”*

7. Enjoying the humorous moments of life

In a rather personal interview in preparation for his apostolic trip to Bavaria in September 2006, Benedict XVI emphasized the importance of not taking oneself too seriously and of knowing how to enjoy the little joys of life: *“I am not a man who constantly thinks up jokes. But I think it is very important to be able to see the humorous side of life and its joyful dimension and not to take everything too tragically.”* And he concludes: *“A writer once said that angels can fly because they do not take themselves too seriously. Maybe we could also fly a bit if we did not think we were so important.”*

8. Invoke the saints more often

Benedict XVI had a great devotion to and confidence in the saints, *“these men and women who with their faith, with their charity, and with their life have been beacons for so many generations, as they are for us too,”* he said. At the inaugural Mass of his pontificate on April 24, 2005, he entrusted himself to the vast communion of saints: *“All the saints of God are there to protect me, to sustain me and to carry me.”*

He invites all the baptized to do the same, more specifically by *“following their example, seeking their intercession, entering into communion with them.”* For he says (quoting *Lumen Gentium*), *“our companionship with the saints joins us to Christ, from whom as from their fountain and head, issue every grace and the life of the People of God itself.”*

9. Take time for silence

Despite the busyness of life, Benedict XVI invites us to take regular times of silence, a reliable path to meeting God, a space to let “joy, concerns, suffering” speak, an essential time to discern what is important from what is useless or incidental. “It is hardly surprising that different religious traditions consider solitude and silence as privileged states which help people to rediscover themselves and that Truth which gives meaning to all things,” he noted in his message for the 46th World Day of Social Communications in May 2012. “If God speaks to us even in silence, we in turn discover in silence the possibility of speaking with God and about God.”
