

while we're at it

Dear Friends,

Joy seems so hard to find these days. Even at Easter.

I've got my list of things to worry about that threaten my joy. I'm sure you've got yours as well. Mine is long but includes fear of getting sucked into wars that could escalate into a world war, kids growing up in a society that's sacrificed its values, economic instability and runaway inflation that threaten our security, and control by powerful forces of our social media and information. And plenty more. What's on your list of worries?



But we're not going to live in fear. We're going to see the amazing things God is doing in our midst and put our trust totally in him. God's way is to break out of the light in the darkness and conquer death. He is working now. Do we have eyes to see it all?

Here's a partial list of things I'm seeing. What about you?

Fr. Tom and I heard nearly 11 hours of Confession Monday for about 125 people, and we're doing it again on Good Friday and Holy Saturday for 12 hours more – another 125 folks were reconciled to God. How does something like that happen in such a hopeless world?

Our English and Spanish classes in the faith will bring a couple of dozen people to complete their sacraments and get their marriages validated. Amazing in a "secularized" world!

Brewster Cares helped nearly 50 homeless individuals this winter with a warm, safe place to sleep and we were able to find some jobs and apartments. It gave them dignity and love. Yes, right here in Brewster.

Brewster Cares ESL ran free classes for 500 people, some of whom are also finding their way back to the faith when they see the Church loves them and cares for them.

Gianna's House pregnancy resource center doesn't launch officially till next month (May 16!) but is already helping unwed moms get the love and support they need to choose life. We'll save more babies and their moms and walk with them all the way.

A woman recently came back to the faith with a huge **conversion after 37 years**, in large part because her mom never gave up praying for her. Now she's bringing her own kids along gently. God is good, all the time.

This Easter, where are you seeing God at work in your life?

TRUST EASTER

Easter reminds me that God always has a bigger plan, a better plan than our human minds can conjure. Let us consider some examples. Two weeks ago, our Gospel reading told us the story of Martha and Mary sending a message to Jesus asking him to come to heal their sick brother Lazarus. Rather than come immediately, he waited two days, until Lazarus was four days buried. Distraught, when the sisters saw Jesus, they both said, "Lord, if you had been here my brother would not have died."

In the Passion narrative on Palm Sunday, when Jesus was on the cross, we hear the chief priests, scribes, and elders mock him, "He saved others; he cannot save himself... Let him come down from the cross now, and we will believe in him." Jesus didn't comply, and the Jewish leaders smugly watched him die on the cross.

Let's go way back to the Garden of Eden and consider the fall, the great harm that sin has caused the earth since then, and all the faithful people that have appealed to God for help across the millennia. We might wonder why God isn't responding and healing our broken world. Now let's look closely at our own stories; we wonder why our prayers seem to go unheeded. In my own life, for instance, my husband Kenny battled oral cancer for 21 years and experienced great suffering. Family, friends, and strangers prayed for him for two decades, yet we never got the miraculous healing we all pleaded for.

With time I have been able to see Easter in God's plan for Kenny. He died with strong faith, our sons are devout Catholic men, and I probably wouldn't be working at St. Lawrence and writing this article if it had unfolded otherwise. Lazarus experienced his own Easter when he was raised from the dead. It is a far more glorious honor to be a precursor to Jesus' resurrection than recover from sickness as his sisters had hoped. Imagine if Jesus had come down from the Cross as the elders requested. Jesus would not have been crucified and showed us his true divinity through his resurrection. Easter is coming for our broken world, our broken hearts, broken families... Pray, but then trust. Your Easter is coming too.

Scripture: Read Matthew 27:42-43. What stands out? **Call to Action**: Pray and ask God to reveal to you the Easters he has granted you throughout your life.

early childhood learning center/stations of the cross



It is never too early to start teaching our children about Jesus and we saw that even the **Stations of the Cross** can be taught to 4-year-olds! Our 46 Early Childhood Learning Center Pre-K 4 students experienced praying a child-friendly version of the Stations of the Cross in the church at St. Lawrence O'Toole. Director Kim Santerre led the service, while volunteer, David Ranaudo, father of 4-year-old Alina, carried the cross from station to station.

As an example, for the First Station, Miss Kim read: "When the soldiers said mean and hurtful things and beat you, you stayed quiet even though you knew you had committed no crime. You trusted in God and forgave them."

The teachers and parents responded, "Jesus, help us to learn from your example. When other people mistreat us and do things that seem unfair, allow our hearts to forgive them and love them. Help us not to judge people."

What simple and beautiful messages for all of us to hear!

The lesson continued when they returned to the classroom. The children made their own Stations of the Cross books to take home and pray with their families. Life is messy, and the world can be very crazy, but our hope can be in the future if we have children who learn young to trust in Jesus and rely on his love to nurture and guide them.

At Seasons of Praise, Fr. Jose Felix Ortega of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Bronx, NY, spoke on **Vatican II and the Eucharist**. He explained how the Liturgy is the expression of our faith, our communion with God. Vatican II, in session from 1962-1965, revived the church. The Council at Vatican II wanted to "open the window of the church so the fresh air can come into the church."

Their thought? How can we bring Jesus into the church? Vatican II brought changes that gave us the opportunity to participate more fully at Mass and to understand the Liturgy. God reveals himself and speaks to us in Sacred Scripture so we may come to know him better. Prior to Vatican II, the Mass was said mostly in Latin, with the priest's back toward the congregation. It was difficult to understand and thus, embrace.

Fr. Ortega admitted to us that even he, during his early years, did not fully embrace the Mass. He asked himself "Am I taking full advantage of being in Mass? Am I nurturing myself?"

Fr. Ortega spoke to our hearts. "How can we participate better so the Mass becomes even more beautiful, a personal expression of our faith? Your body is in the pew but where is your heart and soul?" He suggested we prepare better for Mass in prayer, and we become more attentive at Mass, to focus on Jesus and not on what is going on around us. He shared a parishioner's displeasure with how long he sat in silence after Communion. Fr. Ortega explained "This is a moment to open your heart and give thanks to the Lord for He is now in us. It is at Communion where the Divine comes to me."

Fr. Ortega asked us to pray to the Lord, "How can I be more present before you so during the Liturgy I am in Heaven?"

do this in memory of me

A week later, Fr. Rich Veras of St. Joseph's Seminary spoke on **Key Eucharistic Themes from Pope Francis** at our Seasons of Praise. Pope Francis always paired Eucharistic Adoration with an increased love - love for the people that God puts in our lives and to see Jesus' presence in those people that Jesus puts on our journey. Pope Francis said "Our Eucharistic Adoration comes alive when we take care of our neighbor like Jesus did."

Father explained that "Do This in Memory of Me," does not mean remembering something from the past in a nostalgic way but being recalled to the presence of Jesus, now, in the Eucharist. John sat next to Jesus at the Last Supper when these words were spoken. Jesus chose John, James, and Peter to be on the mountain during his Transfiguration. Only John followed Jesus to the foot of the cross. John understood. On the cross he saw the Jesus he saw on the mountain, not a broken man on the cross. John's passion emphasizes, in the midst of Jesus' suffering, Jesus' authority. Matthew, Mark, and Luke emphasize Jesus' suffering. God put John and Peter on the same journey. At the Last Supper, John sat next to Jesus; Peter asked who would deny Jesus. John followed Jesus to the foot of the Cross; Peter denied him. John reached the tomb first; Peter entered first. John never gave up on Peter because he saw in Peter what Jesus saw.

Fr. Veras closed: "Apostle John is an icon of Pope Francis' emphasis that there is a relationship between my Eucharistic devotion and my recognition of Jesus in others, mercy in others because I recognize Christ in them; I have hope in Jesus' presence in them and what Jesus is calling them to be." John, the beloved apostle, arrived at the foot of the Cross first but with John's help, Peter did too and became the Rock on which the church is built. We all have people in our life, who are gifts from God who bring us closer to Jesus. Fr. Veras asked we pray for the gift of the Eucharist and the gift of the people Jesus puts into our lives.


Life is normal for everyone else... Am I losing my mind? The pain won't last. Lean into your grief.
