

Our statues have arrived from Italy and during the spring and summer we will be putting them up in the parish prayer grotto and near the new parking lot. We've got some landscaping to do but exciting changes are coming soon.

To date, we've raised \$225,000 in pledges toward our \$350,000 goal.

Dear Friends,

#### "Do not be afraid!"

For me, this has always been one of the most powerful Easter messages from Jesus. He said it to his disciples because he would be returning to the Father, leaving them the work of building the Church and bringing his message to the world. He would send his Holy Spirit to guide them and give power to their witness and their words.

"Do not be afraid" is a message we need to hear today too. There is still resistance to the Gospel of Jesus and the Christian way of life, but we also need to be confident the Holy Spirit is with us and will give our words and actions the power to bring others to Jesus.

So even in a world that can often seem opposed to Christianity, we should not be afraid. He is with us. Do not be afraid to be Catholic and live our faith out in public. Do not be afraid to speak about faith, to invite people to Church, to speak the truth. He will make us effective if we are not afraid of opposition or resistance.

It was beautiful to see the Church packed once again at all the Masses for Easter. It was moving and I gave thanks to God for sending nearly 300 people to Confession during Holy Week.

Today, Dcn. Mark will come back to lead the Divine Mercy Holy Hour at 3:00 pm. Join him and ask God to pour his mercy out on the Church and the whole world.

I'm headed off this afternoon with 28 parishioners to Rome, Assisi, San Giovanni Rotondo, and Lourdes on pilgrimage. Fr. Tom and other priests will fill in during my absence. We'll be remembering you at all the holy sites we visit and will lift you all up in prayer.

#### ACCEPT MERCY

We can read Scripture over and over, and each time recognize something new that can transform our lives. Recently for me, it was Judas' last words. Matthew recounts that after Jesus was arrested, bound, and handed over to Pilate, "Judas, his betrayer, seeing that Jesus had been condemned, deeply regretted what he had done. He returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying, 'I have sinned in betraying innocent blood." Then Judas went off and hanged himself.

Two paragraphs earlier we read, "Then Peter remembered the word that Jesus had spoken: 'Before the cock crows you will deny me three times.' He went out and began to weep bitterly." The spiritual writer, Thomas á Kempis teaches us, "Peter did not fall into the deep pit of despair as did the unfortunate

Judas, but he trusted in Jesus' continuing abundant mercy, which he had often experienced. Thus shedding sorrowful tears, he hastened to do penance, the saving remedy for sin, and found the gate leading to infinite mercy wide open to him."

The plan for Peter to lead the Church did not change because of his denial. Peter's humility and desire for forgiveness allowed the plan to proceed forward. In fact, it taught us that even grave sins like Peter's betrayal can be forgiven by our merciful Savior. Judas on the other hand didn't trust in Jesus' mercy and all hope of him being able to fulfill God's plan for him was lost. Another disciple was chosen to take his place, but his unique gifts and talents died with him.

Peter and Judas responded to their sinfulness in decisively different ways. As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, let us choose to model after Peter. Jesus is offering his mercy to all of us, no matter how grave our sins are, but we have to intentionally accept it. Let us each pray this beautiful prayer from Kempis: "Good and most gentle Jesus, with the sincerest of sighs, I ask you to look upon me with the same compassionate eyes as you looked upon Peter after he had denied you. Hasten to grant me the grace of holy repentance to cleanse me of whatever I have committed against you, whether willingly done or omitted because of negligence... Restore to me the light of new grace, for you do not wish a penitent soul to perish."

Scripture: Read John 21:15-17. What stands out? Call to Action: Ask St. Peter to teach you humility.

## national eucharistic revival

At Seasons of Praise, Deacon Art Weiner of St. James in Carmel spoke on *The Bishop's Eucharistic Revival*. All of the talks during the Lenten Seasons of Praise reflected the power and love of Jesus' Presence in the Eucharist, preparing us for Easter. Deacon Weiner's talk was a beautiful close.

St. Augustine stated: "Although God is all-powerful, he is unable to give more; though he's infinitely wise, he knows not how to give more; though vastly rich he has not more to give." He has given us his all.

In 2019, 69% of Catholics personally believed the bread and wine are only symbols of the body and blood of Christ. Although shocking, Deacon Weiner asks us to think of ways to bring Christ back into our homes, not to spend time placing blame.

Deacon Weiner shared the story of his transformation from a Jewish background (more ethnic then Jewish) to a Catholic Deacon. His conversion began when he witnessed Catholics receiving the Eucharist. He recalled their focus. He was captivated by their deep love and devotion. He said, "I want what they have." He turned to the New Testament and "God slowly moved from a vague idea to a person, and I experienced a love I did not deserve."

"Evangelization cannot be left to the professionals, the clergy, the theologians," he said, "But must be a way of life for each of us to spread the Good News to others. We need another pandemic, but this time a spiritual one. We all must become missionary disciples in Christ." A rabbi once said, "If not me, who? If not now, when?"

Deacon Weiner shared details of the National Eucharistic Revival to take place in our country: a movement to restore understanding and devotion to this great mystery of the Eucharist, to help renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, to be drawn into a deeper intimacy with our Eucharistic Lord, allowing our eyes to be opened and our hearts to be set on fire. The pilgrimage with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will begin at four sides of our country - in San Francisco, the tomb of Blessed Michael McGivney in New Haven, CT, the U.S. Mexico Border near Brownsville, Texas, and in the Diocese of Crookston in Mississippi. Each route will end in Indianapolis, Indiana, the setting of the July 2024 Eucharistic Congress. This pilgrimage will be a powerful testament to our faith. We remember during Covid when Fr. Gill brought Jesus to us in the Blessed Sacrament, standing on the back of Deacon Mark's pickup truck holding the monstrance. Multitudes of people lined the streets waiting for Jesus. It was beautiful. Now, imagine that on a much larger scale. Hearts will be transformed.

St. Augustine stated: "It is that Sacrament and that alone, the Christ in our midst. . . It is He alone who holds our world together and keeps us all from being poured headlong and immediately into the pit of our eternal destruction... And I tell you there is a power that goes forth from that Sacrament, a power of light and truth, even into the hearts of those who have heard nothing of him and seem to be incapable of belief."

The National Eucharistic Revival, a true expression of our faith, an invitation to others to join a bold statement of our undying love for Jesus and us is what we need right now. This is our response to the Rabbi's question of who and when. As missionary disciples let us seek our own deeper walk with Jesus as we pray for our hearts to be transformed and begin to heal our broken world and bring Jesus back into our hearts.




