














DONATE TODAY AND HELP US BEAUTIFY THE PARISH GROUNDS

Our statues have arrived from Italy and during the spring and summer we will be putting them up in the parish prayer grotto and near the new parking lot. We've got some landscaping to do but exciting changes are coming soon.

To date, we've raised \$230,000 in pledges toward our \$350,000 goal.

And all donors at those levels will be remembered on a special Memorial Donor Board in the new wing of the Church. while we're at it

Dear Friends,

Our parish pilgrimage to Rome, Assisi, and Lourdes brought us to places where our Catholicism first grew and flourished and where God worked mighty miracles to confirm the faith of our ancestors. Rome, Assisi, Lourdes - all places touched in profound ways by contact with the God who makes himself seen. Those places speak of the faith of earlier generations of believers and make us reflect on our own.

We visited the excavations under the great Basilica of St. Peter where the bones of that first pope were found. Peter, the one who had denied Jesus Holy Thursday night, gave his life in 64 a.d. as a martyr witnessing to the truth of the Resurrected Jesus in what was then a Roman forum, crucified upside down.

In Assisi, where a rich nobleman in the 1200s heard the call of God to give witness of a radical following of Jesus in poverty and simplicity and gave it all away. With the power of the Holy Spirit, a new reform movement called "Franciscans" was born and revolutionized a Church which had grown lax and all too comfortable.

In Lanciano in the year 750, Our Lord decided to manifest the truth of the Sacrament of his Body and Blood and during a Mass, the host changed into visible flesh and the wine into visible blood. Today the tests come back positive for myocardial (heart) tissue and blood (type AB). It just so happens to match the blood on the Shroud of Turin...

In Lourdes, God sent his Blessed Mother to appear to a peasant girl in 1858. The unschooled Bernadette would come away from those encounters telling everyone the "lady in white" told her "I am the Immaculate Conception." Today thousands gather nightly for a candlelight procession to pray the rosary...

It all spoke to me of *the legacy of faith* we pass on. That's what a parish does, and so this week we bring forward our young children for First Holy Communion and our teens for **Confirmation**. We hand on to them what we hold most precious. We've been passing it on since 1871 in Brewster and 1934 in Patterson. Pray for them so they too pass on the treasure of faith to their future kids too.



a spiritual journey

Our pilgrimage with Fr. Gill to some of the most sacred places in Italy and France started at the Roman Catacombs of San Calixto. Fr. Gill and Fr. Justin celebrated Mass deep down in the burial place of the early Christians. What an incredible and moving experience as the Holy Spirit was beginning to reveal the magnitude of how this group was going to form an everlasting bond.

St. Paul's Beyond the Walls was one of the three major Vatican Basilicas we would visit, each one boasting stunning mosaics, statues, and art depicting famous scenes from Christian history. We toured the Roman Forum, the Arch of Constantine, the Coliseum, "The Bone Church of Rome" and much more. We were blessed to have an audience with Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square, where he spoke about his passion for evangelization and how he wants the example of the martyrs to inspire our efforts to bear witness to the Gospel as we await the coming of God's kingdom of reconciliation, justice, and peace. Our tour guide took us through St. Peter's Basilica, the Vatican Museum, and the Sistine Chapel, which left us all in awe. Another highlight was the Scavi Tour of the necropolis below the Basilica where we saw the bones of St. Peter.

Some other Italian holy places we visited were Orvieto for Mass at the beautiful Cathedral and to witness the actual chalice cloth involved in the Eucharistic Miracle of 1263 AD. Then on to the hilltop village of Assisi to learn about Saints Francis and Clare, visit their cathedrals, and the Hermitage

of the Carceri, where St. Francis and his Friars retreated from the world to pray and fast. The views were spectacular! Lanciano is where the oldest Eucharistic Miracle is exposed. A magnificent drive with the Adriatic Sea and snow-covered Apennine Mountains took us to our next stop at Padre Pio's home of San Giovanni Rotundo. We learned about this remarkable saint, visited his tomb, and walked through the sanctuary. Fr. Gill and Fr. Justin were handed the actual glove and crucifix of St. Padre Pio to bless our religious items.

At Lourdes, France, the Grotto was a place of beauty, peace, and serenity. We were privileged to attend Mass at 6:15 am in the cave of the grotto, with Fr. Gill and Fr. Justin as co-celebrants. We spent most of the day washing in the waters, learning about the life of St. Bernadette, spending quiet time meditating and praying in the shrine, and being in the presence of our Blessed Mother. The night ended with a Torchlight Procession with thousands of people from all different cultures coming together as one in our love, hope, faith, and trust in God, and honor for our Blessed Mother.

We prayed for our family, friends and fellow parishioners back home. We left as pilgrims and returned as warriors of Christ. Our faith has been renewed, and we returned home with a newfound peace and better knowledge of our Catholic heritage.



ILLUSTRATING THE GOSPEL

One of the most compelling proofs that Jesus' Resurrection and therefore Christianity are true is the behavior of the Apostles. Their confidence, boldness, and willingness to give their life for their faithful witness to the Truth that the Gospel must be proclaimed to the world, no matter the cost. And it isn't just the twelve that dedicated their lives to Jesus, but the millions of Christians who, once they knew the Truth, offered their skills and talents to serve God as they knew best.

A beautiful realization of mine, while on pilgrimage in Italy and Lourdes, was of the artisans throughout the centuries who have also given their lives to spread the Gospel. The basilicas, cathedrals, and churches in Europe are very elaborately

embellished with sacred art. There appears to be no surface on floors, walls, or ceilings that hasn't been ornamented with paint, mosaic, carving, or relief. The Catholic Church, since its founding 2000 years ago, has had the responsibility of teaching people of all languages and education levels the story of salvation. Sacred art was the means for people to come to know God's love through the illustrated Old and New Testament stories. They learned the stories of the saints from the statues, icons, and stained-glass windows.

The beauty and the powerful messages conveyed by these talented artists took my breath away. It became clear to me that it was not just a job for those mostly unknown craftsmen, but a vocation. The fine detail, mathematical excellence, and uplifting interpretations could only have been accomplished through God's inspiration. We know some of the famous artists, but there are far more unnamed talents who spent years working on one mosaic or mural in one small unknown church. Men and women who dedicated their lives to spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the way they knew best, in the way God inspired them to serve Him. Just as the Apostles wouldn't have sacrificed their lives for a myth, these talented artists wouldn't have either. I trust that they now appreciate the splendor of heaven and are helping to inspire the sacred artists of our own generation.

Scripture: Read Exodus 35:10-19. What stands out? **Call to Action**: Allow sacred art to help enrich your faith. Good art can penetrate our hearts more deeply than words.
