Dear Friends,

Let's thank the **Holy Spirit for his work last weekend** on Pentecost. Our Spanish community had several teen and children baptisms and a total of 45 people receiving the sacrament of Confirmation! Now they go out to bring the Gospel to others...

Mark next Sunday on your calendar to join the parish in our annual **Corpus Christi Procession at 3:45 pm**. It's a powerful experience of walking through the streets of Brewster along with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, from the train station up to the Church. By doing this, we renew our faith in his Real Presence and give a witness to the world of the power of Jesus in the Eucharist. We will have Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament when we reach the Church.



And mark **Saturday, October 21** for a bus trip from the parish to beautiful Auriesville, west of Albany. It's the day of the great New York State Eucharistic Congress at the Shrine of the North American Martyrs, where St. Isaac Jogues and St. John de Brebeuf were martyred and where St. Kateri lived. The New York bishops are organizing 10,000 Catholics for a weekend of Eucharistic Revival, and we'll be traveling up for the whole day Saturday to be part of this exciting event.

It started the other day, but you can still get in on it – the **Genesis to Jesus** mini-course will help you understand the big picture of the Bible from beginning to end. It shows how everything in the Old Testament leads up to and is fulfilled in Jesus. You'll get all your questions answered! Check this bulletin and the website for registration.

And register now for the fabulous production of **MOSES at the Sight and Sound Theatre** in Pennsylvania on **August 1**. We'll take a parish bus for the occasion to see this show and have lunch on the way.

Finally, we open our long-awaited parking lot expansion this weekend. It will give us 24 new parking spaces and will relieve congestion on Prospect Street. Remember it is one way in, and the exit is on Eastview Avenue.

compassionate listening

Living in a Christian community requires us to help our neighbor, to support and walk with each person we encounter in a selfless and loving way. Accompanying others as they navigate life's challenges requires a heart to listen generously. Pope Francis reminds us that we must "remove our sandals before the sacred ground of the other." Whether we are supporting our spouses and children, friends and co-workers, or women who face unexpected pregnancies, we must develop the skills to listen effectively.



I recently had the opportunity to participate, along with about 100 others, in the **Listening Workshop** given by Sr. Virginia Joy and Sr. Hope from the Sisters of Life. In attendance were Gianna's House volunteers as well as average parishioners interested in improving their communications skills.



You might think that listening is easy; we hear, we listen. However, there is much to learn about listening! It is very easy to become distracted and not really listen at all. Sr. Virginia Joy and Sr. Hope helped us understand the key to listening well is being attentive to the speaker's

thoughts, feelings, and points of view. As listeners, we can show understanding by listening carefully and then briefly re-stating the speaker's thoughts and feelings in our own words without evaluation or judgment. This is called **reflective listening**.

Reflective listening requires careful self-management. To listen well, we need to stop talking, still our minds, and be attentive to what the other has to say. It is helpful to put oneself in the other person's shoes and imagine the situation from their perspective.

The next time you are in conversation with someone who needs your help, remember you have been invited into a sacred space with that person and have the opportunity to really listen and bring Christ's peace to them. NO REWRITES

It is fascinating how God has revealed himself slowly, over a very long period of time. It has not been his design to teach any one group his full plan, be it Abraham and his tribe, Moses and the Israelites, his chosen Jewish people during David's reign or Jesus' disciples. Rather than write a story and reveal too much, making the tale tedious and predictable, God has penned the most epic, evolving tale possible and He is allowing his characters to interrupt the plot, reroute the storyline, and be the heroes and villains.

We are today's characters living in this chapter of the great Story of Salvation, but this chapter has emerged from previous chapters and will set up the next one. Since everything we know now was revealed in the past, it is critical that we thoroughly read back over earlier chapters and learn from the

people who have come before us. They have witnessed God's revelations and have shared them with us in written form and oral tradition. It is the accumulation of the experiences of God revealing himself to his people over thousands of years, that has produced the deposit of faith that we have today. If the world lasts another 2000 years, the future faithful will surely have a greater understanding than we do now. God doesn't need or want any of us to understand everything. He has revealed exactly what He wants us to know today.

Interestingly, about halfway through the story, God sent his Son to validate the revelations given to the early faithful. Jesus fulfilled their prophecies, taught the Kingdom of God, and changed the trajectory of the storyline by redeeming the sins of everyone in the story from Adam and Eve to the last people born just before Jesus returns.

God does not teach us individually; he has given us faithful mentors, and he expects us to learn from their credible teachings, writings, and stories, then pass his message on to our children, family, neighbors, and friends – to spread the Good News. At the end of time, this story will be bound forever with no opportunity for edits or rewrites. Let us all be the heroes we want to be remembered as when humanity spends eternity rereading our chapter.
