

while we're at it

Dear Friends,

I want to apologize to everyone at St. Lawrence for the missionary priest who came last weekend on behalf of the Unbound missionary organization. Normally when a mission preacher comes, he presents an inspirational view of the good work his missionaries are doing, reminds us of the Gospel mandate to "go out to all the nations", and makes an appeal for help. Unfortunately, Unbound sent us someone with no Gospel inspiration in his message but instead, only a high-pressure, quilt-laden appeal to sponsor poor people in the third world. A number of parishioners gave me feedback on how much they felt pressured and so I complained about this to the directors of Unbound. I want you all to know I'm sorry I didn't check it more closely beforehand, and I want you all to feel free not to fulfill any financial commitment to the organization if you felt pressured.

We're getting close to building out a new deck at the entrance of Sacred Heart as part of the Parish Improvement

Program Campaign we launched a couple of years ago. It should make the front of the church more attractive and accessible too for the handicapped. It will be done this summer and might take a few weeks of work, so on a couple of Sundays we may all have to enter the church on a ramp. Stay tuned.

Our new parking lot at St. Lawrence is done with the exception of sealing off the water main and replacing a section of the sidewalk. I'd like to ask everyone to remember and respect that it is one way, from the Prospect Street entrance and exiting out to Eastview Avenue. That's best for safety and to reduce congestion near the gym and the church area.

Soon we'll be doing repairs on the main parking lot on the north side and east side (rear) of the Church, and putting down fresh sealer as well. We'll be repainting the parking spaces and creating some additional handicapped spots in the area behind the church, close to the elevator. That should make it convenient for our physically challenged parishioners.

Finally, the statues for the prayer grotto have all arrived and I'm hoping before the end of the summer to have them all installed. Thank you to everyone who has given a gift – you've been so very good and generous.

a pregnancy care center helped me become a mom and follower of Jesus

ANONYMOUS

If someone had told me just four short years ago that my life would be marked by more blessings than I could count, I would have looked at them with complete incredulity. I never dreamed I could be surrounded by the warm love and happiness I experience today. It was all made possible by my unexpected pregnancy and a community that empowered me to take on the mission of motherhood.

I was raised in a small trailer with no electricity, let alone love, support, or a good example. I would try to take my younger siblings places and be outside with them, never knowing that my intention was to protect them from what occurred inside our small, four walls. I couldn't let my innocent siblings see or smell the copious drugs that had consumed our mother for years. They deserved as much of a childhood as possible, despite not knowing where their next meal would come from, which was often a bag of rice dusted with salt.

Taking on the role of "mother" toward my siblings as a young teenager was never in my plan. Needless to say, it was hard, and I was incredibly frustrated as a child raising three other children. Then, at 15 years old and to my utter dismay, I became pregnant.

Getting an abortion was my immediate decision, thinking I could barely take care of myself, let alone my three younger siblings. The mere thought of bringing a new life into this messy situation at my age was more than I could bear — or so I thought.

Knowing my situation, a teacher at my high school asked to connect me with the Pregnancy and Family Care Center (PFCC) in Leesburg, Florida, a ministry under the Christian Care Center. I was unsure of what to expect from the center, but not knowing where to start, I agreed. After speaking with the thoughtful, compassionate staff at PFCC, I was given a complete list of all of my options, in addition to more information about the abortion procedure itself. I realized I couldn't put my child through such a horrific

event, and I knew in my heart that I'd never cope with the regret that, tragically, so many post-abortive women feel. I decided to keep my child, which gave me great peace, even though I knew it would be hard to care for another little one at just 15 years old, while also raising my three siblings. This challenge has helped me grow in my faith and not limit my abilities.

Thankfully, the PFCC, and the surrounding community, were ready. They provided me and my baby with more free resources than I could imagine, ranging from ultrasounds to diapers, car seats, baby clothing and food, transportation, hygiene products, and even new clothes for me to wear at school — something I never had growing up. The women there became my mentors, my friends, and my family. Most importantly, they helped me to discover a real relationship with Jesus Christ, accepting Him into my heart forever and then following the Lord through baptism.

For the first time in my life, I had a devoted support system, and a firm foundation to raise my child upon. I was no longer worried about the atmosphere my son would experience because my world was now packed with kind, loving, and generous people who deeply cared about not only my baby, but me and my younger siblings.

While not by blood, I was given a family that loved me as their own. Today, four years later, I share my story to show other women that there is hope, love, and healing available to them. Due to my past, for my safety, and for the safety of my son, I tell it anonymously.

I can't even begin to count the blessings I have in my life. Despite the odds against me, I graduated high school on time with the rest of my class. I now have a wonderful job. My siblings and I currently live with our grandfather, and I'm thankful we're still together as a family. My son is, without a doubt, the greatest gift from God. Knowing the immense happiness he brings to my day, he is my greatest blessing.

My surrounding community and the women at the PFCC have been blessings for me, my family and my child. We are able to heal because of their love and support. I will never be able to thank them enough or repay them for all they have done. When I count my blessings each night, I count them, and my baby, twice.





PLEASING TO THE HEART

Genesis to Jesus, our summer Bible study program, started a few weeks ago and I am attending it. I love studying Scripture. I took my first class in 2010 and attended every program our parish has offered since. Reading God's Word and meditating on it gives us great insight into the meaning of our life and God's great love for us. Genesis to Jesus is a good program because, in a few short weeks, it gives us an overview of the Old and New Testaments and reveals the parallels in those books and between them and our lives today.

One comparison that struck me this week came from the Genesis story of the fall of our first parents. The serpent tempted Eve to eat from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. She knew she shouldn't, so she made a half-hearted attempt to dispute the invitation. Giving in too easily it seems, she accepted

the serpent's testimony and made her own appraisal: "that the tree was good for food, pleasing to the eyes, and desirable for gaining wisdom."

It is interesting to note that we were taught in the study that when God created Adam and Eve, he breathed divine life into them. That tells us that they were very intelligent and well-prepared for any test. So, when God instructed Adam, (Eve hadn't been created yet.), "You are free to eat from any of the trees of the garden except the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. From that tree you shall not eat; the moment you eat from it you are surely doomed to die," Adam knew what death was and that he wouldn't want it. We can dismiss any notions that they were naïve or uninformed.

That said, I have been focusing on Eve's appraisal, "pleasing to the eyes..." Don't we all do the same thing? Isn't our society entranced by the things pleasing to the eye? We all know what is right and wrong, what God expects of us. He has made his laws abundantly clear since the beginning of time and circulated them across the earth: on stone tablets, in the Scriptures, through preachers, parents, and in our hearts. Yet we still think that we can make our own judgments and if something is pretty or appealing in some way, then it must be good for us. Our first mother shows us the error of that thinking. Surely, she wishes she had trusted God. We are not naïve or uninformed either; we cannot listen with our eyes; we must listen to our hearts.

Scripture: Read Genesis 3:1-7. What stands out? **Call to Action**: Pray to Eve and ask her to help you follow God's wisdom, not your own.


