while we're at it

Dear Friends,

Society is getting more and more confused about what a family is and what makes a good marriage. You'd think that it would be pretty clear from history what marriage and family are and how to make them work better. One man, one woman, in a freely undertaken life-long commitment to fidelity and open to the gift of new life in children. All the studies show this institution of marriage is the best way to social stability and to pass values on down through the generations, as well as the best way for men and women to find happiness and a sense of self-worth.

But today we're told there are all sorts of families and we can define for ourselves what a family is. It's hard to see how that can work in society because true communities are built on stable family life. Changes to the family have long-term consequences as we are already seeing.

In just a generation or two, we've grown accustomed to easy divorce and remarriage. But all the evidence shows this is not good for kids at all. With the acceptance of same-sex marriage partners raising children or procreating through surrogate mothers, we've embarked on a big experiment and no one can predict how that will turn out for the mental health of future generations. We just accept the fact that many couples are living together and raising children outside of marriage. That's destabilizing, because it means less committed and looser bonds between people.

All these things weaken marriage and the family, and once upon a time the government understood the health of the whole society depended on healthy marriages and families and actually supported marriage. But that has changed so much.

It's unfortunate that even many Christian groups have accepted this new status quo and pretend it's not really a danger. The Catholic Church has stood for 2000 years for the institution of one man, one woman marriage up to death. Our role is to be "the voice crying in the wilderness" a prophetic role that speaks the truth in charity, "in season and out of season."

But like John the Baptist learned, speaking the truth brings persecution. That is the price tag for fidelity to the teaching of Jesus.

Eventually the society around us will hear and listen.

God of our life, there are days when the burdens we carry chafe our shoulders and weigh us down; when the road seems dreary and endless, the skies gray and threatening; when our lives have no music in them, and our hearts are lonely, and our souls have lost their courage. Recently, I participated in **Fearless**, a three-night video series led by Chris Stefanick which focused on helping us face fear with fortitude. The above prayer was our opening prayer. It described well how each of us had felt, at least once in our lives Jesus never promised us an easy life. He did promise he would never leave us, and he sent us an advocate, the Holy Spirit. We are never alone. During the sessions, I learned how fear can paralyze us and impact our lives. I learned ways to manage fear. I was reminded that if my life does not align with God's Will, there is no point.

We watched videos of witness stories of individuals who faced fear and overcame fear with God by their side. The Women's Oklahoma Softball Team described how their joy is found in the Lord. These are young college women quoted as saying "I didn't feel filled. I had to find Christ. I think that is what makes our team so strong. We are not afraid to lose. The only way you can have a Joy that does not fade away is from the Lord." The women were inspirational and hopeful. We live in a broken world far removed



from what God intended. We need to be contemplative. We need to speak boldly of our faith. In Matthew 10:33, Jesus says "But whoever denies me here on earth, I will also deny before my Father in Heaven." The videos discussed how social media if allowed to, plays an integral part of who we are.

The series provided an array of suggestions on how to face fear, one being having a mantra, a word repeated to aid in meditation. My disciple group uses their favorite scripture. . . "Jesus I Trust in You," "The Lord is my Shepherd, there is nothing I shall want" and "My yoke is easy, and my burden is light" to name a few. God is always with us.

The last night shared two very emotional videos, both of which were witness stories by young women facing a life-changing and a terminal illness. Fear was overcome with acceptance and peace because of their faith in God. They accepted the cross handed to them. Not many of us, at any age, would be so accepting. The attitude portrayed by both these young women showed courage and an understanding of what God is asking from each of us. Every single generation has its own set of fears and struggles. How do we overcome them? Who are we aligned with? Fearless is a beautiful series that brings us back to basics and where our focus should be allowing us to have faith over fear.

The parish will run FEARLESS again in the fall. More people need the peace and assurance that we received this summer. Come then. You'll be glad you did.

“When things change, God is with you.” This was the motto for our Babylonian **Daniel’s Courage in Captivity Vacation Bible School** which started on Monday, June 26th. The kids learned songs with motions all week long, as well as participated in fun activities such as making necklaces, nameplates, flutes, and jewelry boxes!

We also talked about God-sightings each day. We would ask the kids, “Where did you see God today?” They would see God in all sorts of things like butterflies, trees, and each other!

The kids learned about Daniel’s story each day with an interactive play. On day four they were left with a cliffhanger: Daniel had not obeyed the King’s decree to pray to him alone and Daniel continued to pray to the one true God. He was arrested and thrown into the lion’s den! They had to wait until Friday to learn that God had sent his angel and closed the lions’ mouths! Daniel was saved and through Daniel’s powerful witness to the one true God, the King also acknowledged the one true God! The campers loved the story of Daniel and the lion’s den and we think they really related to him.

We hope the kids will continue to have faith as strong as Daniel even when things get tough and they go through trials and tribulations. Just like Daniel knew when things get tough, God is with him, He is with all of us too!

One of the kids’ favorite songs from VBS was ***Stand Firm***. The lyrics go like this, “*Stand firm when life changes. Stand firm through the ups and downs. Stand firm for we know that God is in control. The storms of life will push and pull, but we are standing on the rock that never rolls.*” This song sums it all up. God is the rock that never rolls!



We had such a great week teaching God’s truth to thirteen amazing campers. When the kids went home and told their parents all about what they learned, I am sure it sparked great conversations!

The kids were wonderful! They had hearts that were willing to learn more and more about Bible stories. It was so fun to see that so much of the kids’ excitement grew each day!

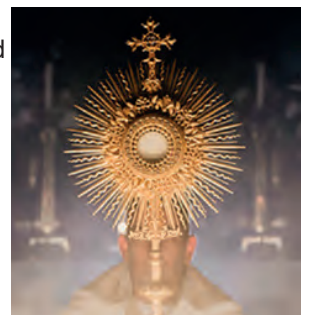

TO HEAL OR NOT TO HEAL

Last Friday we watched Season 3, Episode 2, of **The Chosen** at movie night in the gym. In an important scene, Jesus sits down with his apostles and explains that he is going to send them out two-by-two to preach the Gospel, heal the sick, and expel demons. He further detailed that they will take nothing for the journey but a walking stick - no food, no sack, no money, not even a second tunic. They were to trust the Father to provide.

The Chosen is a historical drama of the life and ministry of Jesus with a big focus on the apostles and Jesus' relationship with each of them. A very poignant scene followed when Little James approached Jesus privately. Little James is depicted with a deformed spine; he walks slowly and with a limp. This humble,

faithful follower summoned the courage to ask Jesus how he could be expected to heal others when he himself was broken. He saw himself as inadequate compared to the others and he finally asked the question that had been nagging him, "Why won't you heal **me**?"

Jesus replies, "Listen carefully because what I am going to say defines your whole life. In the Father's will, I could heal you and you would have a good story to tell. But think of the story you have, especially in this journey to come, if I don't heal you: to know how to proclaim that you still praise God in spite of this. So many people need healing in order to believe in me. Or they need healing because their hearts are so sick. That doesn't apply to you. Many are healed or not healed because the Father in Heaven has a plan for them."

The lines of this script spoke to my heart. They sounded like the message Jesus has for you and me when we pray for healing for ourselves and others, and it doesn't come. He has a journey for each of us, and most of us are limping along, feeling inadequate and comparing ourselves to others. God's healing or not healing is part of a bigger plan, not an oversight. Let's claim Jesus' final words to James for ourselves: "Remember, you will be healed. It's only a matter of time."

Scripture: Read Mark 6:7-13. What stands out?
