# while we're at it

#### Dear Friends.

We don't normally worry about suicide unless we have had the tragic experience of a friend or a loved one who has been a victim. But an article I read made me start to wonder about it. It seems that the suicide rate rose 5% last year and there were nearly 50,000 in this country. I was shocked at the numbers, and it seems like it is at epidemic proportions... after all, that is nearly the number of losses we had in the ten years of the Vietnam War in just 2022!

On top of that number, we also had 109,000 deaths attributed to all sorts of drug overdoses, an 18% increase over the year before. That's more people than who live in Brewster and Danbury combined!

Those all are preventable deaths. Why do so many in our society see life as such a burden and look to escape it somehow? What leads to such deep and widespread depression that people look for relief in these frightening and irreversible ways?

There are so many reasons, I suppose. Severe depression, lack of good understanding of and treatment for mental health issues, the powerful addictive tendencies of drugs like fentanyl or meth...



But from my point of view at least, there is something even more fundamental. Once we had a culture that had a sense of what life was about, a direction to things, a meaning to the world we inhabit. We knew we were creatures made in the image and likeness of a good God. And that we each had a purpose because that God freely chose to call each of us into being - not as some kind of evolutionary accident - but as persons willed by God into existence with a purpose. And that ultimately our lives had meaning in the plan he set for us - and that would bring us to eternal life and happiness with him.

We believe in that as Catholics, but the wider society really doesn't believe that our lives have any transcendent meaning. To most, we're just making our way through several decades of existence, with no real point to it all. We get a job and form a family, keep ourselves busy and distracted. Not much hope in that picture of the human person.

But everything changes, and starts to take on meaning if we truly are made "in the image and likeness of God", and if "God so loved the world that he sent his only Son so that the world might not perish but have eternal life". We've got to get people to see life that way once again.







# 20-yr-old's reunion with birth mom has surprising twist

Holly Shearer from Utah had made what she now calls the most difficult decision of her life. When she was 15 years old, she decided to give her yet unborn child up for adoption.

Being in her sixth month, she began looking for new parents for her son. Through an adoption agency, she made contact with Angela and Bryan Hulleberg. The married couple had been struggling with infertility for years.

The teenager connected immediately with the couple. She decided that the Hullebergs would give her child what she would not be able to provide for him. "He deserved a mother and a father, a home with a playset in the backyard that he can play on, a dog, all of those things I couldn't give him," Holly told KSL TV5. Her son, Benjamin, was born in November 2001.

#### A wonderful childhood

Angela and Bryan rose to the challenge and provided the boy with a wonderful childhood. All the time they were aware that his biological mother truly loved him and had placed him in their care out of genuine concern for his well-being.

### Best wishes for his 20th birthday

When Benjamin turned 18, he decided to find his biological mother. Since it was a closed adoption, he knew only her name. Holly had also begun to try and contact her son.

The woman was luckier than Benjamin, who didn't manage to gather much information. Holly found him on the internet and followed him on social media for several years. Finally, having gathered her courage, she wrote to him on his 20th birthday. She introduced herself and wished him well. The young man was extremely excited and wanted to meet his mother to thank her for her courageous decision to adopt. He understood that her sacrifice had given him a wonderful and safe life.

#### They work in the same place!

One day, Holly and Benjamin and both families met for dinner. It turned out that the boy was a volunteer in the neonatal intensive care unit at the hospital where Holly works as a nurse!

"Every morning, I would come in through the women's pavilion to come into work. So I passed right by the NICU every single day. We parked in the same garage, could have been on the same floor, had no idea that we were so close," Shearer told Good Morning America.

What's more, Holly and Benjamin had lived about 5 miles apart for many years! Mother and son are extremely happy that they didn't give up trying to find each other. As a result, Benjamin was also able to meet his half-siblings!

#### WHY DO IT ALONE?

Over the last couple years, my son Tim and I have enjoyed watching the History Channel series, Alone. Ten survivalists compete to stay the longest in very inhospitable areas of the world. In each season of the show, ten men and women are dropped off alone in a specific region with only the barest necessities (and an abundance of camera equipment).

To survive this brutal environment, for potentially 100 days and win the big prize, they must build a good shelter, procure nutritious food, and protect themselves from injuries and local animals: for instance, predators that may try to kill them and mice that will eat their bow strings or berry cache. There is no end to the conflicts and likewise no end to the creativity that the competitors exhibit.

But we have watched several seasons by now and as prayerful Catholics, we have found it absolutely astounding that none of the participants ever pray. They film themselves in very compromising and emotional situations, tell very personal and painful stories, scream out in anger and frustration, weep from pain and discouragement, but never appeal to our great God for help.

As the weeks unfold, everyone loses dangerous amounts of weight. They are always camped by a big lake, but few are able to catch fish. They make poles, nets, baskets and generally have poor results. I wonder what might happen if one asked Jesus to fill his nets. When they trap a small animal or shoot large game, they commonly thank the animal for giving up its life, rather than thanking the God that provided the animal. The weather gets worse, injuries, frostbite, and malnutrition eliminate participants one-by-one. Might some of them have lasted longer if they had called upon our great Healer to cure the digestive ailment or sprained ankle?

Confidence in our own skills and experience is a good thing, but we limit our opportunities and potentially miss out on the big prize if we refuse the supernatural help God can give us.

Scripture: Read Mark 11: 22-24. What stands out?

**Call to Action**: Consider your strongest skills and talents, then ask God to pour out his grace to make them even greater.
