

September 17, 2023 while we're at it

Dear Friends,

We Catholics often feel like we're on the defensive, that we have something to apologize for, and we have to justify ourselves because we are out of sync with the broader culture around us. That idea has to go where it belongs – to the trash bin.

An ancient Christian writer captured the right attitude long ago, when the Church was a tiny minority and without any influence. He said, "The church in the world is like the soul is to the body," in other words, it is the Church that gives life to the rest of the world. It's true – without the influence of Christianity, society would be without values ("might makes right") and division and violence would be multiplied many times over.

G.K. Chesterton wrote that the problem with the world isn't that Christianity has been tried and found wanting, but that it has never really been tried. How true – if we could permeate and influence all the institutions of society with true Gospel values, we would have a completely different world. The world needs the Church, in spite of its blemishes, because it needs Jesus and needs the truth. We're not perfect, but we are the hope of humanity.

Pope Francis coined a phrase a few years ago and I love it. He said the Church needs to be "*permanently in mission" to the world and not on the margins or hiding out, waiting for "better times*". Nor could the Church ever be just an exclusive club for insiders. He stressed the missionary nature of the Church, much like St. John Paul II. We are always reaching out, proposing Gospel truth to the world that does not know Jesus Christ. Because he is "the Way, the Truth, and the Life" for every single human person.

That's the spirit we try to live in our parishes here. It starts with prayer before the Blessed Sacrament (Have you dropped in this week yet?), striving for personal holiness, and a commitment to draw others (Friends, coworkers, family members?) to Jesus as well.

Jesus Fest this weekend is a celebration of that spirit of confident, joyful living of the fullness of our Catholic faith. Be sure to join us in the Adoration Tent!

Shepherds Speak Holy Hour Tuesday at 7:00 pm is another piece of that effort. Bishop Whalen will be joining us this Tuesday, the 19th to share his personal experience of the Eucharist. Join us and live your Catholic faith proudly.





ENTHRONE YOUR HOME

In the eleventh century, Christians began the devotion of meditating on the five wounds of Jesus, and from there emerged the prayers to his Sacred Heart. Over 600 years later, a French sister named Margaret Mary Alacoque began receiving visions of Jesus. He allowed her to place her head on his heart, and she experienced the comfort of his presence. He told her He wished to be honored with the symbol of his heart, asking for the faithful to make amends for any wrongdoing they had done, frequently take Communion, and observe the Holy Hour.

The compliment to that devotion is the Immaculate Heart of Mary which celebrates the Blessed Mother's interior life, celebrating her joys and sorrows, her virtues, and her love for God. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus focuses on how Jesus' heart is full of love for us; the Immaculate Heart of Mary reflects on how Mary's heart is full of love for the Savior.

The Spring issue of the Sisters of Life's Imprint magazine encourages us to enthrone Jesus in our homes. They explain: "When you place or "enthrone" an image or statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in your home and have it blessed by a priest, you are saying, "Jesus, You are King of this house. Come and reign here. Fill this house with Your presence, Jesus. Calm the storm. Cast out the darkness and the confusion. And bring your purity, forgiveness, and healing to our family." Jesus is our King and Mary our queen. By inviting Our Blessed Mother with her Immaculate Heart into our homes as well, we are saying, "Mary, ask Jesus to turn water into wine. Let there be miraculous healings in our family. Be our advocate."

Fr. Gill, Fr. Hernandez, and Fr. Clifford want to help you enthrone Jesus and Mary in your homes, so we will be selling images of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary in our Gift Shop at Jesus Fest. A schedule will be available for you to choose a day and time for one of the priests to come to your home and bless the images. If you already have prints or statues in your home, they can bless those – no need to buy new ones, but we hope you will use this opportunity to tell Jesus that you trust Him and want Him to watch over and protect your family. God knows you need Him!

Scripture: Read 2 Timothy 4:18. What stands out? **Call to Action**: In addition to your own home, consider buying prints for family and friends to enthrone theirs as well.
