

Dear Friends,

I hope you made it to the **Jesus Fest** last weekend – it was totally awesome, with hundreds of kids and families passing through the Adoration chapel in the big tent, doing the scavenger hunt and the Saints Walk, or visiting the "how to pray" tent, or picking up some tortillas for a bite to eat. It had everything – good spirituality, the Blessed Sacrament, fraternity, parish spirit, charity, and good fun.

And that's what a parish is all about – building a community of people centered around the worship of Jesus in the Eucharist. For all our faults and defects, we are still God's people, and we're walking together, sometimes limping along with the help of each other, but taking little steps in the right direction and trying to let Jesus take over our lives more and more. The closer we get to God, the closer we get to each other.

Getting close to God has got to be our goal... every one of us. A great way is to learn more about your faith. Fortunately, we offer a lot of great mini-courses to keep growing and understanding what we believe. Check out the Fall offerings in Adult Faith Formation here in this bulletin.

We're organizing parish buses to leave in the morning for the Shrine of the North American Martyrs and return that evening. There will be Mass, Eucharistic Procession, great speakers, food, and fun.

We're blessed to have all this going on, and we're smart if we take advantage of it all.

Next Saturday is a big event for Brewster Cares at Las Mañanitas: a fundraiser for our homeless shelter, which runs December through March and gives the unfortunate among us a warm place, food, and love. We need to raise money for that, and for our ESL program for immigrants to give them a shot at success. Come on out to help.

GLIMPSES OF HEAVEN

We own a timeshare in Aruba and I have been traveling there for over 30 years. While there, every night we convene on the beach by 6:30 pm to watch the sunset. There is something mesmerizing about watching our fiery star make its final descent, touch the horizon, and sink into the sea. Sometimes there are clouds, sometimes clear skies; it can look different every day. Year after year I would take pictures, but most recently I began noticing that my photos look nothing like the sunset my eyes see. The colors can be flipped so that a white sun looks orange; the sky might look dark when it is light or orange when it is blue. We have tried cameras, iPhones, Androids, GoPro, and they all fail miserably. Our attempts all provide interesting and beautiful pictures, but they do not capture the real thing.

I experienced that same phenomenon at Jesus Fest last weekend. A beautiful altar was erected to host the Blessed Sacrament for adoration in the big revival tent. The drapery, altar cloths, and lighting enhanced the monstrance so beautifully that it sparkled with life. I don't have the words to describe it adequately and my phone failed again to capture what my eyes saw. If you were there, you know what I mean. If you weren't, trust me that any photos we post do not do it justice.

Our event musicians, Danielle Rose, Sheila Valastro, and the St. Lawrence Band stirred our ears in a similar mystifying manner. A note, a chord, or a verse would touch me in an otherworldly sort of way. It caused me to ponder on what heavenly music sounds like. Was God giving me a glimpse of heaven? Might the angels have been performing alongside?

As Catholics, we know that when we are in Jesus' presence: at Jesus Fest, in our churches, and in our Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel, we are in heaven. Wherever Jesus is, angels and saints surround Him. The veil that divides our realities is drawn back and the heavenly ones worship among us. At the very least, remember that 200 people in the church means 200 guardian angels accompanying them! Look around and absorb that truth. Then stay alert for the flash or sparkle, note or chord, breeze or chill that is otherworldly, that you can't describe or record, and thank God for that glimpse of heaven.

Scripture: Read 1 Corinthians 2:9-10. What stands out? **Call to Action**: Watch for those glimpses in God's creation as well: in the clouds, fall foliage, birds, flowers, little children...


