

Dear Friends,

This past Wednesday Pope Francis started the **Synod in Rome** to discuss issues in the Church with bishops and lay people. Cardinal Dolan is there for the whole month. The assembly has drawn a lot of criticism because many seem to be headed there from places like Germany with ideas of radically changing the Catholic faith we know. There are definitely such individuals going with an agenda. Pope Benedict warned the Church that what is important is not our plans and agendas, as good as they may be. What is important is that we - both the Pope and all of the Church - listen to the Holy Spirit and his plan. Jesus promised the Holy Spirit would guide his Church. So let's pray that he guides these meetings in Rome.

Meanwhile, we're focused on doing what really matters - forming kids and families in our faith, promoting Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, hearing Confessions and celebrating the Eucharist, and bringing new people into the faith.

We're offering a great lineup of classes this Fall for adults to grow in faith - on finances, on Scripture, on the Eucharist. We've got a great support group for those grieving. Check it out in our bulletin and see what can help you grow in faith.

We've got 20 small groups running weekly to help us form good spiritual friendships and help each other grow in faith. Maybe it's time you joined one.

We're running programs to teach immigrants English, shelter for the homeless, tutoring for kids, and outreach to women with unplanned pregnancies. Plenty of opportunities for you to volunteer...

There's an old slogan – "All politics is local." I'd like to adapt that a bit: "All good religion is local." – It happens in the parish church, in small groups, in homes. That's where faith gets real and personal – between each person and Jesus.

That's what our faith is all about.



PAUSE

For the last couple of weeks, I have been reflecting on the Gospel reading about the landowner who hired laborers to work his vineyard. Some men were hired early, and they worked a full day for him. Others worked for lesser amounts of time; some as little as an hour. At the end of the day, he paid them all the same and that is where the ruckus begins - for the laborers and for us.

From a young age, we begin to consider ourselves authorities on fairness. Long before the age of reason, preschoolers vent their frustration by screaming, "It's not fair!" So even though we weren't the ones sweating all day in the vineyard, our human nature sees the owner's behavior as unjust. Clearly, the landowner wanted to

make his generosity known to all because he could have avoided the controversy entirely by paying the first-hired laborers first. Each group could have walked away satisfied never knowing what the later groups earned.

But rather than just looking at it from a financial point of view, let's consider what was accomplished that day. The landowner needed workers to transform his fields. The laborers who were there a full day made a bigger impact on the health and productivity of the vineyard than the ones who only worked an hour or so. Before leaving, the men who labored a full day could have paused and looked at the large section of field they worked and felt a great sense of satisfaction.

I want to look at my relationship with Jesus the same way. He invites all of us into his Kingdom. Some people begin following Him as children, others as young adults or in middle life. Others resisted Jesus' call until their last years or deathbed, but no matter when the conversions occur, Jesus, like the landowner, is generous with all of us. As disciples, no matter when we entered God's service, let us pause and reflect on our years of toil and sweat with a sense of accomplishment knowing we are positively impacting the health and productivity of his Kingdom.

Scripture: Read Matthew 20:11-12. What stands out?

Call to Action: Embrace the idea of working hard for God and reflect on what you can accomplish rather than what you will receive.


