


















# while we're at it

Dear Friends.

We've got a lot to be thankful for in being Eucharist-centered parishes at St. Lawrence and Sacred Heart. With hundreds of people each week making a holy hour or visiting our Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel, there are graces flowing all the time to our communities and our families. The Eucharist is the center of the Catholic Faith and the Mass is the celebration of the sacrifice of Jesus for us. Nothing is more important to us than Jesus' Real Presence among us in the tabernacle and the monstrance.

That's why I was proud that more than 160 of our parishioners made the pilgrimage last Saturday up to the Shrine of the North American Martyrs for the NY State Eucharistic Congress. There we gathered with 7,000 Catholics from all over the state along with our bishops from eight

in the Eucharist.

It was beautifully done with the best music and the best speakers, on a sacred site where, nearly 400 years ago, the French missionaries St. Isaac Jocques, Rene Goupil, and John Lalande were killed by Native Americans for their Catholic Faith. They shed their blood at that site outside Albany because they were passionate about the missionary mandate given to us all by Jesus: "Go therefore to all the nations and baptize... teaching them to observe all I have said to you" (Mt. 28). Like so many other heroes of the faith, these brave and devout men show us the way to live for Christ.

Pope St. John Paul II called the Eucharist the "greatest gift" of Jesus to his Church. Let's grow in our appreciation and our gratitude for it.

# The Eucharistic Congress Unites Believers in Worship and Adoration

Parishioners from St. Lawrence O'Toole and Sacred Heart attended the New York State Eucharistic Congress for a day pilgrimage on October 21st. Three buses from St. Lawrence O'Toole left at the earliest hours of the day to venture up to the Shrine of North American Martyrs in Auriesville to encounter our Eucharistic Lord. With the hilltop view of the changing autumn leaves and the brisk fall air, it was a beautiful day for prayer. There was a total of 165 St. Lawrence parishioners that attended, with around 10,000 people in total from all corners of New York. Those in attendance were Bishops, priests, seminarians, consecrated religious, and parishioners of all ages.

The day was centered around our belief of Jesus being fully present in the Eucharist. When we receive Him in Mass or pray to Him in adoration, we believe that Jesus is fully there: body, blood, soul, and divinity. The hope for the events throughout the day was that they would create a revival of our belief in the Eucharist and people's love for Jesus within their hearts, homes, and parishes. There were various talks of how the Eucharist can transform different parts of a person's life, as well as Mass with Bishop LaValley, praise and worship, and Adoration. The highlight of the day was the Eucharist procession, where Jesus was carried around the grounds with all the thousands of attendees following in solemn song and prayer.

As we made our journey back, and as we have returned to our day-to-day lives, we pray that a revival of the power and realness of the Eucharist touches the hearts of all of those who attended and all of us within the parish.















#### THE INVITATION

Recently, I had a conversation with a middle-aged man who was convinced that the next stage for him was paradise. He was not on the brink of death, just sharing his personal worldview of what he expects to happen when he dies. He had been raised Catholic in another country but hasn't gone to Mass or Confession or received the Eucharist in decades. He explained that he couldn't attend Mass because he had to work all the time, but when I mentioned 8 AM Mass, he quickly protested that he couldn't get up that early. He had no concerns that these omissions would impact his place in paradise one day.

I think that is common with a lot of people: believing that heaven is naturally the next destination and that we will automatically be

reunited with our predeceased loved ones.

This conversation reminded me of the recent Gospel reading of the king who invited guests to his son's wedding feast. It can seem shocking to us that his guests weren't interested. Why didn't they feel honored to be invited? How could they justify showing such blatant disrespect for their king by ignoring his invitation and just returning "one to his farm, another to his business"? Their host had made great preparations, killed the fattened calf, and was looking forward to celebrating the blessed event with his guests. It would also have been an opportunity for those attendees to develop a closer personal relationship with Him and His Son.

The man I spoke with, and so many others, are doing the same thing today. They won't take time off from their farms and businesses, sporting events and nature walks to come to Mass and partake in the sacraments, to celebrate with our Lord and show their thankfulness for his kindness and generosity. As disciples, we need to remember to be grateful for the invitation to spend time with our King, at Mass, in Adoration, and in private prayer. If we do not show our desire to spend time with Him now, He will not have a seat reserved for us with Him in paradise later.

Scripture: Read Matthew 22:2-5. What stands out? Call to Action: Consider every Mass, Adoration visit and prayer time to be an invitation from our King, God the Father, to develop a closer relationship with Him and his Son, Jesus.




