come to surviving the holidays

Two years ago, I attended **Surviving the Holidays**. My husband and several family members had died that year. I hesitated, being in denial that this would be helpful to me. But I accepted the challenge and joined many others to learn strategies for handling the upcoming holidays and social events. It made me focus on looking ahead to avoid some sadness and despair. Without this guidance, I would have avoided thinking ahead to the holiday season, because it somewhat frightened me as to how I might react.

Instead, this session was an inspiration to me as it recommended that we prioritize holiday activities, then only do the

ones that we enjoy the most. We discussed starting new holiday traditions and not feeling obligated to accept invitations to events that will be too difficult this year. They also suggested that we could ask party hosts to understand if we decide not to come the day of the event or leave early; it is natural for the emotions of grieving people to change several time a day. I was also reminded to be thankful to God for my blessings and trust in Him that I will be able to overcome the fear of these celebrations ahead.

That 2-hour session helped me have a happy holiday season in spite of the grief I was feeling. It may take time to heal, but in the meantime, we need to find joy.

while we're at it

Dear Friends,

You may have heard reports over the last month or so about the “Synod” going on in Rome during October. They’ve just finished up work with hundreds of bishops, priests, religious and lay people having meetings and discussions on how the Church should move forward in our time. Pope Francis is trying to promote a culture of listening and discerning and that is all good because, in our polarized times, we need to listen more and understand more.



Problems arise, however, when some people, such as representatives of the Church in Germany, use such meetings to push their local agendas. Those are in various ways efforts to use the Synod process to create some sort of permanent assembly of clerics and laity to replace the bishops and the pope and make binding decisions for the whole Church. Or when some try to legitimize homosexual unions or ordination of women. Those are settled questions, and they are matters of divine revelation and Catholic doctrine.

Many Protestant denominations have gone the route some are suggesting for the Catholic Church and it has had terrible effects in most places. There is no real authority and doctrinal decisions tend to reflect the spirit of the times and the fads of each generation. That’s very different from the way we Catholics have always understood doctrine.

We believe that Jesus entrusted to St. Peter, the first pope, and to the apostles, the first bishops, authority over the whole Church and beginning with Pentecost sent the Holy Spirit to guide them to discern the meaning of all He had taught them and discern God’s will for the Church. So “revelation” is something revealed by God to us through the people He appointed over us. Naturally, that involves listening to others, to the people, and reading the “signs of the times.” But most of all it means listening to the Holy Spirit and fidelity to the truths he has revealed over the past two thousand years.

Any other understanding of revelation runs the risk of us “making it up as we go.” For as careful and compassionate as we want to be, we need to remain rooted in the truth of Jesus and what he said and did. The Holy Spirit speaks in a special way to the pope and bishops together, and we work to live out that truth in our lives.

Pray for our Church that it remains firm and be a beacon of truth for a confused world.

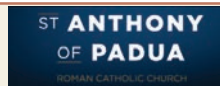

Learning at a legal conference

Last week Father Gill, Julie Noce, and three other members of the Board of Directors of **Gianna's House** (Gina Sinon, Catherine Corales, and I) spent four days at NIFLA -- the National Institute of Family and Life Advocates--annual conference in Chesapeake, Virginia.

With pro-life speakers from around the country, the Summit presented topics directly related to CEOs, board members, attorneys, volunteers, and medical personnel committed to serving life-affirming pregnancy centers.

Lectures and presentations included everything from lawyers reviewing court cases that had occurred around the country in support of unfettered access to pregnancy help centers (for example) to lectures by doctors and nurses advising on best practices for opening pregnancy centers. There were also many vendors showing the latest models of ultrasound machines and other things of interest or necessity in opening a pregnancy help center.

The amount of material presented was enormous. But the information conveyed and the opportunity to connect with those who had up-and-running pregnancy help centers will bear fruit in our own **Gianna's House's** mission of loving and assisting women facing unplanned pregnancies.

Since that day, Carol texts me regularly extending good wishes for celebratory events like birthdays, weddings, and holidays, acknowledging memorials like the anniversary of my husband's

birth and death, and offering prayers for challenges that she knows my family is experiencing. At first, I assumed that Carol was learning of these events from Linda, but as time passed, I saw that she must have my family's important dates logged.

Her notes are sweet and thoughtfully written, using words and phrases like "beautiful Lynda," "beautiful friend," "abundant blessings," and "delightful day." She includes festive emoticons and pretty GIF images, so her messages always make me smile. A couple of months ago, when she wrote wishing me a happy birthday, complete with a pretty animated cake and musical notes, queen's crown, and toasting champagne glasses, I responded, sheepishly apologizing, that I do not know and acknowledge her special days. She replied, "This is my favorite pastime!"

Think about that. Carol has made me so happy with her cheerful notes, even on not-so-cheerful occasions. Certainly, she is also sharing her kindness and joy with countless others on a weekly or even daily basis. I realized that without founding a corporation, formulating a mission statement, fundraising, and advertising she had instituted an important ministry to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ to others. A friend of a friend, loving her neighbor in a way that comes naturally and joyfully. Let us all consider how we can follow Carol's witness and make loving others our favorite pastime.
