

## while we're at it

Dear Friends.

The old saying about the Church is true... "If it ain't cryin', it's dyin". That's why we welcome babies and kids in our two churches and run family-friendly programs in religious education, Kidz Chapel during Mass, and a healthy and professionally run early childhood learning center. It's why in most programs we run for adults, we offer child care alongside them so that busy parents can bring the kids along without fretting about babysitters. Kids? Bring them in – we love them!

We're blessed to be baptizing between ten and fifteen new Catholic kids each month, in English and among our Spanish community too. Our baptisms outnumber funerals by a lot. Kids are the future.



Passing on the faith to the next generation is something so deeply embedded in our Catholic faith that we often don't give it a second thought. The Catholic faith is a lifestyle and an identity, and parents live the faith out in practice and teach it to their children. They teach it like they teach kids to speak, to read, to write, how to behave in public, what good manners are, and how to respect others.

Catholics baptize babies because we see every child as a gift and a responsibility, and we want those children to be part of God's family right from the start. It's who we are so we share it with those we love. We want kids on the path to salvation, which begins with baptism and becoming part of the family of God. We train them from their earliest days to love God and others and to make the Gospel come alive in their way of living every day.

And that's why at our parishes we take seriously how the parents and godparents are living their Catholic faith when they bring a child for baptism. Each of them makes an oath to God at the altar that they will model the Catholic faith and help that child in the practice of the faith. Nobody can give what he hasn't got. Do you have what it takes?

So in choosing godparents, it's not just the next uncle in line or the cool auntie who is so much fun. It's definitely not a Michael Corleone "settling the family business" as he serves as godfather to Connie's baby. It's not someone who doesn't go to Church or is married outside the Church. It's got to be a person serious about their relationship with Jesus and striving to live with God in the center of their lives.

Passing on the faith is one of the most important responsibilities God entrusts to parents. Do it well. It's the best gift you can give to your child.

#### SCIENTIFIC DIGNITY

Today's science allows expectant mothers to follow their baby's weekly development from test-positive to delivery. At our **Gianna's House Pregnancy Resource Center**, we have a jewelry-style box, one that might house precious pearls, with four small rubber models of babies in the first trimester. Those perfectly formed figures show us that at such an early stage, they are already clearly developing human beings.

At 7 weeks, the child is the size of a coffee bean, but their facial features are visible, their eyelids are forming and their heart is beating at twice the rate of their mom. By 10 weeks the baby is about the size of a plum and squints, swallows, frowns, and puckers up its brow. Tiny baby teeth are forming

in the gums, and its heart resembles a small version of a newborn baby's heart.

Week by week, science allows us to follow the fascinating facts that surround this new child. It is predictable. You and I followed this course of development within our own mother's wombs, and our great and great-great grandchildren will develop the same way.

That means that since Jesus was fully human, He most likely developed this same way too.

The Christmas story has taught us that Jesus, King of the Universe was once a newborn baby. For hundreds of years, Christmas creches and artist renditions have helped us envision Jesus lying in a manger with Mary and Joseph in the cave. Now, science can help us appreciate the months and weeks leading up to his birth. This weekend, Jesus' Mother would be about 35 weeks pregnant. Mary of Nazareth was feeling her baby growing, stretching, and kicking within her. Let us use science's deeper understanding of human development to appreciate Jesus' humanity more deeply too. And allow Jesus's incarnation to give even greater dignity to all babies developing in their mother's wombs.

**Scripture**: Read Luke 2:4-7. What stands out? **Call to Action**: Let us use these weeks leading up to Christmas to pray for all mothers and their unborn children.
