#### Dear Friends,

I always start the New Year by writing a list of things I'd love to see happen in the next 12 months, and I thought I'd share.

- 1. I'd love to see peace break out and people stop trying to solve problems by killing each other. Let's pray for peace in Ukraine and especially in the Holy Land, the place where Jesus was born.
- 2. Could someone wave a wand and make our politics kinder and gentler? Could we recover the respect we need to listen sincerely to each other and try to understand where they are coming from?
- 3. Let's try to see people as individual persons, each unique and interesting and not just a part of a racial or ethnic or religious group, and treat them with respect and reverence.



At the parish I always have a list ready for God of what I want (I know, I know... I should be trying to figure out what He wants, but here's my list for what it's worth...):

- Grow our number of disciples in small groups from 150 to 250... all working to help each other grow in love for Jesus and supporting each other on the way...
- Increase the number of **Eucharistic adoration** people with hours each week from 200 to 250.
- Grow our LifeTeen Youth Ministry to 50 high school kids.
- Establish a great Young Adult Ministry.
- Bring back "the lost"... I want to get a few hundred more people to attend Church weekly.
- Keep increasing the number going to **Confession** and even add another day of Confession to handle the numbers.
- Increase our religious education program from 510 to 600 kids.
- · More weddings and baptisms in Church. That's the future!
- That Brewster Cares helps each homeless person and immigrant discover he is loved by God by experiencing the love of God's people.
- That Gianna's House saves more and more babies from abortion and supports the moms spiritually, psychologically, and materially.

I'm glad you're along for the ride. We need disciples, and we need volunteers to get involved and make all this happen. Maybe it's time for you to jump in. What is God asking you to do in 2024?







#### **MAKING ROOM**

I have been listening to the daily C.S. Lewis reflections on Hallow throughout Advent. I love the way Lewis uses ordinary life analogies to help us better understand spiritual truths. A wonderful one that I want to share with you reflects on Mary's experience of carrying the growing baby Jesus within her.

The Hallow narrator explains, "As the months of her pregnancy progress, Mary makes more and more room for Christ within her body, literally. Her skin stretches to accommodate her growing belly. Her ribs expand as the child pushes against her lungs. And her whole body rearranges to serve the presence of Christ within her. If we look to Mary as an example, especially on the cusp of Christ's birth, we are reminded that this process of inviting Christ to dwell within us is not necessarily going to be a comfortable one. There will be changes we will have to make. Ways we will be asked to stretch and grow."

In Mere Christianity, Lewis uses the idea of a living house to explain the idea further: "Imagine yourself as a living house. God comes in to rebuild that house. At first, perhaps, you can understand what He is doing. He is getting the drains right and stopping the leaks in the roof, and so on. You knew these jobs needed doing and so you are not surprised. But presently, he starts knocking the house apart in a way that hurts abominably and does not seem to make any sense. What on earth is He up to? The explanation is that He is building quite a different house from the one you thought of. You thought you were being made into a decent little cottage. But He is building a palace. He intends to come and live in it Himself."

To truly invite Jesus into our lives, we need to make room for Him. Room in our day, our mind, our heart. We all know the fundamental repairs needed in our living houses but only God knows our grand potential. Are you going to settle for living alone in a decent cottage, or open up your heart's doors for Jesus to enter with all of his tools and plans to renovate you into a palace large enough for Him to dwell too?

**Scripture**: Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. What stands out?
